NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for NGA Championships)

Advice:

In addition to the provisions of Rule 8-1, the Note under Rule 8 is in effect. Thus, each team may appoint only one head coach to give advice to, or ask for advice from, participants on that team provided that:

- a) the appointed head coach wear the identification band provided by the host,
- b) the advice is given between the play of two holes once the entire group has completed play, and
- c) the advice is given in a private manner that does not unduly delay play.

Penalty for breach of condition:

By a player – two strokes.

By a coach – two strokes will be added to the coach's team score.

Abnormal Ground Conditions:

Ground Under Repair may include areas of unusual damage but only when so declared by a member of the Rules Committee.

Flower and Plant Beds are deemed to be Ground Under Repair even though not so defined by white lines.

Staked Trees are deemed to be ground under repair even though not so defined by white lines. Relief may be taken for interference of the stance or area of intended swing involving the stake, wires or tree itself.

Range-Finding Devices:

The use of range-finding devices by players and/or coaches is not permissible during the stipulated round or during a suspension of play of that round.

Electronic Communications:

The use of electronic communication devices by student-athletes is prohibited during the stipulated round.

Obstructions:

The markers indicating 200, 150 and 100 yards are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1.

Out of Bounds:

The practice range is out of bounds and marked with white stakes.

Holes #15, #16 and #17 - Out of Bounds is defined by the road along the right side and behind the green on #16. A ball is out of bounds when it lies on or beyond the road.

Play-off:

In case of a tie for the team championship, concerned teams will play-off hole-by-hole beginning on hole #17 until a winner is determined. Team score will be determined by the best four of five scores on each hole.

In case of a tie for the individual championship, concerned players will play-off hole-by-hole beginning on hole #17 until a winner is determined.

Scoring Areas:

The Scoring Area is defined by the area under the tent near the lower practice putting green.

Teeing Ground:

The Cottonwood Tee-Markers define the teeing ground for the competition.

Transportation:

Players must walk and carry their own bags at all times during a stipulated round. Optional Condition as prescribed in Appendix I is in effect.

Exception: Players may accept transportation from #7 putting green to #8 tee; from #15 putting green to #16 tee and from #18 green to #1 tee, otherwise players must walk at all times during the stipulated round.

POSSIBLE PROBLEM AREAS

Hole 1 White stakes along the left – Out of Bounds; Red stakes and lines left and behind the green – Lateral Water Hazard.

Hole 2 Red stakes and lines along the left and right of the green – Lateral Water Hazard; Yellow stakes and lines crossing in front of the green – Water Hazard.

Hole 3 None.

Hole 4 Red stakes and lines around the lake – Lateral Water Hazard.

Hole 5 Red stakes and lines right of the green – Lateral Water Hazard.

Hole 6 Red stakes and lines along the behind the green – Lateral Water Hazard.

Hole 7 Red stakes and lines along the left – Lateral Water Hazard.

Hole 8 Yellow stakes and lines in front of the teeing ground – Water Hazard; Red stakes in front of the teeing ground – Lateral Water Hazard; White stakes along the left – Out of Bounds.

Hole 9 White stakes along the left – Out of Bounds; Red stakes and lines around the pond – Lateral Water Hazard.

Hole 10 White stakes along the right – Out of Bounds; Red stakes and lines along the right and behind the green – Lateral Water Hazard.

Hole 11 Red stakes and lines right of the green – Lateral Water Hazard; Yellow stakes and lines in front of the teeing ground – Water Hazard.

Hole 12 None.

Hole 13 None.

Hole 14 None.

Hole 15 Road along the right – Out of Bounds.

Hole 16 Red stakes right of the tee – Lateral Water Hazard; Road along the right and behind the green – Out of Bounds.

Hole 17 Road along the right – Out of Bounds; Red stakes and lines crossing in front of the green – Lateral Water Hazard.

Hole 18 Red stakes and lines in front of the teeing ground and along the right – Lateral Water Hazard; Yellow stakes and lines crossing the fairway – Water Hazard.
