Eligibility

Entries are open to amateur golfers who will have reached their twenty-fifth birthday by September 26, 2008. Entrant must be a resident of Nebraska and a member of the Nebraska Golf Association. If needed, the championship field may be limited to those players with the lowest USGA Handicap Indexes as of the eleventh revision, dated September 17, 2008.

Amateur Status: *All players must conform with the USGA Rules of Amateur Status as specified in the USGA Rules of Golf.*

Entries; Form, Fee, Closing Date

All players shall apply on NGA forms. Forms may be obtained from the NGA office or NGA web site (www.nebgolf.org).

Entry fee of \$90 shall be paid by every player. Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the NGA (402-505-4653) is notified before the close of entries. After the close of entries, fee will be refunded in the case of injury or illness, if requested by September 25. No refund for any reason after September 25. A \$25 service charge will be deducted from all refunds.

Late applications are not acceptable and will be automatically rejected. (Entries by telephone, telegraph, or FAX not acceptable.) Time limit for entries means time of receipt at NGA (not time entry is sent to NGA). Entries should be submitted early to allow ample time for delay or error in transmission. The risk of delay or error in transmission lies solely with the entrant and the NGA shall have no liability with respect to any such delay or error and the consequences therefrom, including rejection of the entry.

Format; Schedule

CHAMPIONSHIP DIVISION:

The Championship division will be made up of those golfers that declare championship.

NET DIVISION:

The Net division, determined by order of entry, will be made up of those golfers that declare net.

A) Stroke Play – 18 Holes stroke play to determine 16 championship division qualifiers and 8 net division qualifiers for match play. A tie for the last qualifier's place in either division shall be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole play-off.

FRIDAY, SEPT. 26, 18-holes.

B) Match Play – General numerical draw will be used in both divisions. For purposes of determining places in the draw, ties in qualifying rounds shall be decided by a blind draw, except that places of those participating in a play-off shall be determined by the order on the public scoreboard summary and by performance in the play-off.

SAT. A.M., SEPT. 27, First Round, 18-holes (both divisions)

SAT. P.M., SEPT. 27, Second Round, 18-holes (both divisions)

SUN. A.M., SEPT. 28, Semifinals, 18-holes (championship)

SUN. P.M., SEPT. 28, Finals, 18-holes (both divisions).

In the event of a tied match, (a) the winner shall be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole play-off and (b) the stipulated round is deemed to extend to as many holes as are required for a match to be won.

Prizes

CHAMPIONSHIP DIVISION:

WINNER: Crystal trophy and custody of the Nebraska Mid-Amateur Championship trophy for the ensuing two weeks.

RUNNER-UP: Crystal trophy.

LOWEST QUALIFYING SCORE: Silver medal; if a tie, duplicate medals will be awarded.

MERCHANDISE PRIZES: TBA

WINNER: Crystal trophy.

RUNNER-UP: Crystal trophy.

Rules of Golf; Close of Competition

Play will be governed by the Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA. Questions shall be settled by the Nebraska Mid-Amateur Championship Committee, whose decision shall be final. Competition shall be deemed to have closed when the Championship trophy has been presented.

Golf Balls

Only brands of golf balls on the most current USGA List of Conforming Golf Balls may be used. This list is updated monthly and may be found on the USGA web site at www.usga.org or by contacting the USGA technical Department at (908) 234-2300.

Footwear

It is a condition of the competition that shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. Penalty for breach of this condition: DISQUALIFICATION.

Caddies

A player may provide his own caddie. If he wishes the host club to furnish a caddie, he should ask the NGA because sufficient caddies may not be available at the host club.

Publicity and Promotion

By submitting an application, the player agrees to allow the NGA to use the player's photographic/video image for any NGA media related use(s).

Score Posting

All Championship scores will be posted for handicap purposes. Players *should not* post these scores individually.

Transportation

Automotive transportation is permissible.

Time of Starting

Note under Rule 6-3 and Optional Condition as prescribed in Appendix I shall be in effect.

Practice Privileges

If desired, those entered may contact the Players Club golf shop at (402) 963-9950 to arrange a practice round at an available time one week prior to the championship.

Conditions; Schedules

The NGA Rules Committee reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The decision of the NGA Rules Committee in any matter shall be final.

Personal Appearance

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and may withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply.

Tournament Information

A memo to contestants including groupings and starting times will be mailed or e-mailed after the close of entries. If you have not received a memo within four days of the Championship, it is your responsibility to contact the NGA Championship Department. Tournament information will also be available on-line at www.nebgolf.org.
