From Omaha:

Take HWY 75 South to Nebraska City and turn left onto H Road (gravel road) proceed .5 miles east and the club house will be on the right hand side of the road.

Arbor Links is located just south of Kimmel Orchard and directly west of Arbor Day Farm

DRESS CODE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply. Generally, competitors should adhere to the following dress code: Only shirts with sleeves and collars may be worn. Shorts may be worn but jeans or denim shorts are not allowed. The following items are forbid: tank tops, cut-off shorts, jogging shorts, and gym shorts. **Absolutely No Metal Spikes.**

PRACTICE ROUNDS

If desired, up to ten golf team members and their coach may play a group practice round at ArborLinks prior to the competition. Coaches should contact the ArborLinks Golf Shop at (402) 873-4334 to make proper arrangements. The fee is \$30/player; carts are available for the regular rate. Regular fees would apply to those participants requesting individual practice rounds.

FORMAT

The format is 18-holes of stroke play at ArborLinks. The lowest four scores of each team shall count towards the team score. The team with the lowest score for 18-holes will be the team champion. The individual with the lowest score for 18-holes will be the individual champion. Any tie for team and/or individual champion will be played-off as follows:

- a) Tie for team championship—teams will play-off hole-by-hole, scoring the best four of five scores on each hole, until a winner is determined.
- b) Tie for individual championship—individuals will play-off hole-by-hole until a winner is determined.

TEAM REGISTRATION

All coaches and players should register in person upon their arrival at ArborLinks. Registration will be located just inside the clubhouse from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m.

PRACTICE AREAS

Practice areas will open at 8 a.m. on March 27th. Range balls will be available on the driving range for competitors use through the final starting times.

CARTS AND COACHES

Automotive transportation is complimentary to coaches during the competition. Each coach will be designated a cart stationed for pick-up just outside the golf shop. These carts will be labeled with the name of the school. Use of carts is restricted to coaches only. A coach using a cart may neither appoint someone to drive the cart nor may he allow anyone to ride in the cart.

Exception: Coaches may transport players from #7 putting green to #8 tee; from #15 putting green to #16 tee and from #18 green to #1 tee, otherwise players must walk at all times during the stipulated round.

STARTING TIMES

Groupings and starting times are included in this packet. It is the player's responsibility to be at his designated starting tee early. An official clock will be present on the first and tenth tees with additional unofficial clocks in all practice areas. The Note to Rule 6-3 and Optional Condition as prescribed in Appendix I shall be in effect.

COACH AND PLAYER'S BOXED LUNCHES

A boxed lunch and drink will be available to players and coaches (\$7) following golf. Please contact Jeff Porter at ArborLinks (402) 873-4334 by **Friday, March 21** with the number of players/coaches from your team planning to eat. Boxed lunches will be available only to those with prior reservations. Payment for the lunch should be made at registration.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE SERVICE

The ArborLinks clubhouse will be open for food & beverage service during the tournament. Team coolers are allowed for snacks and fruit. All beverages must be purchased in the clubhouse; outside beverages are prohibited.

PRIZES

TEAM CHAMPION: Championship trophy and framed print. Silver Medal for coach and team members.
INDIVIDUAL CHAMPION: Silver Medal and framed print.
TOP TEN INDIVIDUALS: Gold Medal.
