Subject: 2010 INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Please forward this information to individuals who might be interested in an internship in golf administration.

Omaha, NE - The Nebraska Golf Association (NGA) office has four internship opportunities available in 2010. The United States Golf Association (USGA) Foundation awarded a grant to the NGA, which will be used to support three of these internships through the USGA's P.J. Boatwright, Jr. Internship Program. This program was established in 1991 to create job opportunities for individuals with a career interest in golf administration, and to assist regional and state golf associations in conducting tournaments, junior golf activities, membership services, and other office responsibilities. A grant from the Nebraska Golf Foundation (NGF) will be used to support a fourth internship which works directly with the Nebraska Junior Golf Tour (NJGT). All prospective interns should demonstrate strong managerial potential and sufficient interest and background in golf.

The NGA is a non-profit organization serving over 160 member clubs and more than 25,000 individual members. The NGA was established in 1966 to foster, promote and advance the interests and the true spirit of amateur golf throughout the state of Nebraska. The NGA staff and volunteer Board of Directors serve their membership in such areas as: handicapping, course rating, rules and championships, as well as providing educational materials, workshops and information.

These full-time temporary positions will pay a stipend of \$1,500/month (gross). Intern is responsible for making his/her own housing arrangements.
