NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for NGA Championships)

Drop Zones:

Hole #2 - As an additional option under Rule 28 (Unplayable Ball), if interference exists from an area located between the green stakes, the player may drop a ball on the closest of the two areas marked "drop."

Hole #5 - As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the lateral water hazard (marked yellow) along the left, the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked "drop."

Deciding Ties:

In the event of a tie for first place, a hole-by-hole play-off will determine the champion.

Abnormal Ground Conditions:

Ground Under Repair may include areas of unusual damage but only when so declared by a member of the Rules Committee.

Flower and Plant Beds are deemed to be ground under repair even though not so defined by white lines. *Exception: Flower and Plant Beds surrounding trees are deemed to be through the green, therefore, no relief without penalty.*

Hole #2 - The plant bed located between the cart path and the boundary fence behind the putting green is deemed to be through the green, therefore, no relief without penalty.

Hole #16 - Turf Nursery located right of the green is ground under repair from which play is prohibited. If interference exists, relief must be taken. Such nursery is not defined, but it constitutes all of the area cut at approximately putting green height or less.

Integral Part of the Course:

Hole #2 - The portion of the cart path behind the putting green between the four green stakes is deemed to be an Integral Part of the Course, therefore, no relief from this area without penalty.

Obstructions:

Yardage posts are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1.

Out of Bounds:

Out of Bounds is defined by the perimeter fence in addition to white stakes.

Concrete Bases of Boundary Fence Posts - are part of the fence and thus not an obstruction.

Hole #4 - Out of Bounds is defined by the curbing of the parking lot along the left side of the green and the road behind the green. A ball is out of bounds when it lies beyond the curbing.

Hole #6 - Out of Bounds is defined by the curbing of the parking lot along the left side. A ball is out of bounds when it lies beyond the curbing.

Hole #17 - Out of Bounds is defined by the fence of the tennis courts behind the green.

Scoring Area:

Scoring Area - A scorecard is deemed to be returned when the player has left the scoring table.

Teeing Ground:

The black tee-markers define the teeing ground for the competition.

Transportation:

Players must walk and carry their own bags at all times during a stipulated round. Optional Condition as prescribed in Appendix I is in effect

Water Hazards and Lateral Water Hazards:

Hole #5 - Water Hazard located left of the green is deemed to be lateral water hazard in play of hole #5.

Hole #7 - Water Hazard located along the right is deemed to be lateral water hazard in play of hole #7.

Hole #13 - Water Hazard located along the left is deemed to be lateral water hazard in play of hole #13.

Hole #15 - Water Hazard located along the left is deemed to be lateral water hazard in play of hole #15.
