Eligibility

Entries are open to Grandparent or Parent and Child teams (including in-laws), at least one of whom must be an active member of the Nebraska Golf Association or a Member/Apprentice in good standing with the Nebraska PGA Section. Entrant must have reached his/her twelfth birthday by August 5, 2010. Amateur participants must have a USGA Handicap Index. Golf professionals are eligible for the gross division only. The field will be limited to 60 teams (120 players) based on order of entry.

Amateur Status: All amateur players must conform with the USGA Rules of Amateur Status as specified in the USGA Rules of Golf.

Entries; Form, Fee, Closing Date

All players shall apply on NGA forms. Forms may be obtained from the NGA office or NGA web site, www.nebgolf.org.

Entry fee of \$150 shall be paid by every team. Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the NGA (402-505-4653) is notified before the close of entries. After the close of entries, fee will be refunded in the case of injury or illness, if requested by August 4. No refund for any reason after August 4. A \$40 service charge will be deducted from all refunds.

ENTRY APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY NGA NO LATER THAN 5 P.M. C.D.T. ON FRIDAY, JULY 30, 2010.

Late applications are not acceptable and will be automatically rejected. (Entries by telephone, telegraph, or FAX not acceptable.) Time limit for entries means time of receipt at NGA (not time entry is sent to NGA). Entries should be submitted early to allow ample time for delay or error in transmission. The risk of delay or error in transmission lies solely with the entrant and the NGA shall have no liability with respect to any such delay or error and the consequences therefrom, including rejection of the entry.

Format; Schedule; Set-Up

Chapman Stroke Play – two players play as partners, each playing from the teeing ground and each playing the partner's ball for the second shot. After the second shot, partners select the ball with which they wish to score, and play that ball alternately to complete the hole.

18-Holes. 60 teams eligible.

The golf course will be set up at varying lengths based upon gender and age. Men will compete from the Cortonwood tees (6,562). Amateur men age 60 and over will compete from the Pine tees (5,819). Women will compete from the Willow Tees (5,092).

Team Handicap Allowance

The player with the lower Course Handicap is allowed 60% of Course Handicap. The player with the higher Course Handicap is allowed 40% of Course Handicap. The total is rounded off with fractions of .5 or more rounded upward. After handicap allowances are determined, Section 9-3c(iii) will be applied to golfers competing from different tees.

Prizes

GROSS and NET DIVISIONS

WINNER: Individual trophies

MERCHANDISE PRIZES: TBD (Based on size of field)

Rules of Golf; Close of Competition

Play will be governed by the Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA. Questions shall be settled by the Rules Committee, whose decision shall be final. Competition in each division will be deemed to have closed when the trophy has been presented.

Golf Balls

Only brands of golf balls on the most current USGA List of Conforming Golf Balls may be used. This list is updated monthly and may be found on the USGA web site at www.usga.org or by contacting the USGA technical Department at (908) 234-2300.

Footwear

It is a condition of the competition that shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. Penalty for breach of this condition: DISQUALIFICATION.

Caddies

A player may provide his own caddie.

Publicity and Promotion

By submitting an application, the player agrees to allow the NGA to use the player's photographic/video image for any NGA media related use(s).

Transportation

Automotive transportation is permitted.

Time of Starting

Note under Rule 6-3 and Optional Condition as prescribed in Appendix I shall be in effect.

Conditions; Schedules

The NGA Rules Committee reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The decision of the NGA Rules Committee in any matter shall be final.

Personal Appearance

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply.

Tournament Information

A memo to contestants including groupings and starting times will be mailed or e-mailed after the close of entries. If you have not received a memo it is your responsibility to contact the NGA Championship Department. Tournament information will also be available on-line at www.nebgolf.org.
