**Directions from I-80:** Take I-80 to Exit 353 (York). Go north about 110 miles on Hwy 81 to Hwy 98. Turn right and go a total of 18 miles (continue east as Hwy 98 runs into Hwy 35) to Hwy 15 in Wayne. Turn left and go 1.0 miles to the entrance road on your right. Turn right and go to the entrance on your left.

**Directions from Lincoln and Omaha:** Take Hwy 275 to Hwy 15. Go north on Hwy 15 about 15 miles to the Hwy 35 intersection in Wayne. From the intersection, go 1 mile to the entrance road and continue as described above.

**FORMAT**

A) Stroke Play – Girls—36 Holes; Boys—54 Holes.

MONDAY A.M, JULY 12, First Round, 18-holes. (Girls)

MONDAY A.M. & P.M., JULY 12, First Round, 18-holes. (Boys)

TUESDAY A.M. & P.M., JULY 13, Second Round, 18-holes. (Boys)

*45 lowest scores and anyone tying for 45th place or anyone within 10 strokes of the leader for the first 36-holes continue play on Wednesday, July 14th; the remainder eliminated after 36-holes.*

TUESDAY P.M., JULY 13, Final Round, 18-holes. (Girls)

*Lowest Score for 36 holes will be champion. A tie for first place will be played off hole-by-hole until a champion is determined.*

WEDNESDAY A.M., JULY 14, Final Round, 18-holes. (Boys)

*Lowest Score for 54 holes will be champion. A tie for first place will be played off hole-by-hole until a champion is determined.*

**PLAYER REGISTRATION**

There will be no formal registration. The NGA requests that contestants check-in at the golf shop counter prior to their first round starting time for any last minute announcements or instructions.

**PRACTICE RANGE**

The practice range will open one hour prior to the first starting time each day of competition. Complimentary range balls are available for contestants and may be picked up in the golf shop.

### **STARTING TIMES**

Groupings and Starting Times for the first two rounds of the boys championship and the first round of the girls championship are attached. You may also access this information by visiting the applicable tournament web site or by calling Wayne CC at (402) 375-1152. It is your responsibility to be at the proper starting tee early (at least 5 minutes). An official clock will be present on the first and tenth tees with unofficial clocks placed in the practice areas. The Note to Rule 6-3 and Optional Condition as prescribed in Appendix I will be in effect.

### **DRESS CODE**

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward. Only shirts with sleeves and collars or mock turtlenecks may be worn and tucked in at all times. Shorts may be worn but jeans or denim shorts are not allowed. The following items are forbid: tank tops, T-shirts, cut-off shorts, gym shorts, earrings (males) and body piercings. Absolutely No Metal Spikes.

### **CADDIES**

A player may provide his/her own caddie. Caddies are prohibited from taking transportation during the stipulated round. *Exception: A player may not use a parent or guardian as a caddie during the championship.*
