FOUR-BALL STROKE PLAY

Rule 23.2b Side's Scorecard in Stroke Play

<u>Side's Responsibility</u>: The side's score for each hole must be entered on a single scorecard.

- The score of at least one partner must be entered on the scorecard for each hole.
- There is no penalty for entering more than one partner's score on the scorecard.
- Each score on the scorecard must be clearly identified as the score of the individual partner who made it.
- Only one partner needs to certify the hole scores on the side's scorecard under Rule 3.3b (2).
