NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for NGA Championships)

Bunkers:

All bunkers are deemed to be part of the General Area.

Deciding Ties:

Stroke Play – In the event of a play-off to determine the final qualifying spot(s), play shall commence at the 1st tee, unless otherwise notified by the Committee, immediately following the conclusion of the applicable stroke play rounds.

Match Play – In the event of a match standing all square after 18-holes, play shall continue beginning on the starting hole of the match.

Drop Zones:

Hole #4 Red Penalty Area - If a ball is in the red penalty area on Hole #4, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke: 1) Take relief under Rule 17.1; or 2) As an extra option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone marked "DZ" located in the fairway. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.

Integral Objects:

Blue Paint Dots - Used to define the depth on each putting green and deemed to be an integral object., therefore, no relief without penalty.

Obstructions:

The Clubhouse and its Surrounding Areas are deemed to be one Immovable Obstruction.

Artificially surfaced roads and paths include those surfaced with crushed brick, gravel or asphalt.

White stakes right of Hole #8, #15, #16, #17 and #18 indicate plot lines, they do not define Out of Bounds and are deemed to be immovable obstructions.

Immovable Obstructions Close to the Putting Green - Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under Rule 16.1. The player also has these extra options to take relief when such immovable obstructions are close to the putting green and on the line of play: **Ball in General Area**. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is: 1) On the line of play, and is: 2) Within two club-lengths of the putting green, and within two club-lengths of the ball. Exception – No Relief If Line of Play Clearly Unreasonable. There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.

Out of Bounds:

Out of Bounds is defined by the perimeter fence in addition to white stakes.

Hole #1 – Out Of Bounds is defined by the edge of the paved highway closest to the golf course along the left side.

Hole #9 – Out of Bounds is defined by the road behind the green. A ball is out of bounds when it lies on or beyond the road even though it may lay on another part of the golf course.

Stroke Play Scoring Area:

Scoring Area – The scoring area is defined by the roped area under the tent near the 9th and 18th putting greens.

Teeing Area:

The Red NGA Tee-Markers define the teeing area for the boys. The White NGA Tee-Markers define the teeing area for the girls.

Temporary Immovable Obstruction:

NGA tents and signage are temporary immovable obstructions. Relief may be taken on either side of these TIO's.

Transportation:

During the round, a player or caddie must not ride on any form of motorized transportation except as authorized or later approved by the Committee. A player who will play, or has played, under penalty of stroke and distance is always authorized to ride on motorized transportation.
