NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for NGA Championships)

Abnormal Course Conditions:

<u>Flower and Plant Beds</u> are deemed to be ground under repair even though not so defined by white lines. *Exception: Flower and Plant Beds surrounding trees are deemed to be through the green, therefore, no relief without penalty.*

Hole #16 – Turf Nursery located right of the green is ground under repair from which <u>play</u> is <u>prohibited</u>. If interference exists, relief must be taken. Such nursery is not defined, but it constitutes all of the area cut at approximately putting green height or less.

Drop Zones:

Hole #5 Red Penalty Area - If a ball is in the red penalty area on Hole #5, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke: 1) Take relief under Rule 17.1; or 2) As an extra option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone marked "DZ" located in #6 fairway. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.

Obstructions:

<u>Hole #14</u> - The mulched bed and cart path surrounding the beverage station have the same Immovable obstruction status as the beverage station. The entire area is considered one immovable obstruction.

Hole #17 – The tennis court behind the green is an obstruction.

Out of Bounds:

Out of Bounds is defined by the perimeter fence in addition to white stakes.

Concrete Bases of Boundary Fence Posts – are part of the fence and thus not an obstruction.

<u>Hole #4</u> – Out of Bounds is defined by the curbing of both the parking lot along the left side of the green and the road behind the green. A ball is out of bounds when it lies beyond the curbing even though it might lie on another part of the golf course.

<u>Hole #6</u> – Out of Bounds is defined by the curbing of the parking lot along the left side. A ball is out of bounds when it lies beyond the curbing even though it might lie on another part of the golf course.

Holes #8 and #9 - Out of Bounds is defined by the wood fence around the maintenance area in addition to white stakes.

Play-off:

A tie for first place will be decided by a hole-by-hole play-off beginning on the 1st hole immediately following play, unless otherwise notified by the Committee.

Scoring Area:

Scoring Area - A scorecard is deemed to be returned when the player has left the scoring tent.

Teeing Area:

The NGA Tee-Markers define the teeing area for this competition.

Temporary Immovable Obstructions:

All Sponsor Signs, Tee Signs and Tents are deemed to be Temporary Immovable Obstructions. Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect. Relief may be taken on either side.

Water Hazards:

<u>Holes #5 and #7</u> - The portion of the pond adjacent to the hole that is marked yellow (water hazard) plays as a lateral water hazard during play of holes #5 and #7.
