96th NEBRASKA WOMEN'S MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP FREMONT GOLF CLUB JULY 15-17, 2019

PLAYER INFORMATION

Thank you for participating in the 96th playing of the Nebraska Women's Match Play Championship co-presented by the Nebraska Golf Association and Nebraska Women's Amateur Golf Association and hosted by Fremont Golf Club. Below is general information to assist with your attendance.

DIVISIONS

Gross - begins with an 18-hole stroke play qualifier Monday morning to determine 16-player championship bracket. Remaining players will be placed in an additional match play bracket (Founder's Flight). The round of 16 will begin Monday afternoon; quarterfinal and semifinal matches will take place Tuesday; final matches are scheduled for Wednesday morning.

Senior Gross - begins with an 18-hole stroke play qualifier Monday morning to determine seeds for match play. Quarterfinal matches take place Monday afternoon, semifinal matches mid-day Tuesday and the final Wednesday morning.

Net - three flights created based on Handicap Index. All flights will play an 18-hole qualifier Monday morning to determine seeds for match play (based on net scores). The First Flight will play quarterfinal net matches Monday afternoon, semifinals mid-day Tuesday and the final Wednesday morning. The Second and Third Flights will play quarterfinal and semifinal net matches Tuesday, the final net match takes place Wednesday morning.

CADDIES, PUSH CARTS and GOLF CARTS

You may carry your own bag, use a caddie or use a golf cart. Push/pull carts are also permitted. If you choose to ride you must rent a cart from the golf shop. The number of carts per group will be limited to two.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE SERVICE—MONDAY AND TUESDAYLUNCHEON BUFFETS

The club's grill room will be available for general food and beverage purchases each day of the championship. A hosted player buffet will be available after the qualifier Monday and between sessions Tuesday (11 a.m. to 1 p.m.).

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Practice facilities will open at 6:45 a.m. Monday, 6:30 a.m. Tuesday and 7 a.m. Wednesday. Complimentary range balls will be available on the practice range.

DRESS CODE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply. Absolutely No Traditional Metal Spikes.

GROUPINGS AND STARTING TIMES

Groupings for the qualifier (8 a.m. shotgun) are available through the championship web site (link below). Match play brackets will be determined following the qualifier. As mentioned previously, the Gross Division, the Senior Gross Division and Net Division's First Flight all begin match play Monday afternoon.

PRIZES

Gross Division (Championship Bracket): Champion – custody of the traveling trophy, trophy and medal to keep; Runner-Up – custody of traveling trophy and trophy to keep; Founder's Flight winner – Medal; Merchandise prizes – awarded to semifinalists, runner-up and champion; Qualifying Medalist – custody of traveling trophy and trophy to keep.

Senior Gross and Net Divisions: Senior Gross Qualifying Medalist – trophy; Flight winners – Medal; Merchandise prizes – awarded to semifinalists, runner-up and winner.
