REGISTRATION

FORMAT

A) Stroke Play —36 Holes.

TUESDAY A.M., JULY 30, First Round, 18-holes.

WEDNESDAY A.M., JULY 31, Final Round, 18-holes.

Lowest Score for 36 holes will be champion. A tie for first place will be played off hole-by-hole until a champion is determined.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Practice areas will open at 7 a.m. each day of the championship. Complimentary range balls will be available on the range. In addition, Beatrice CC features a large practice green near the range.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

Classics is a restaurant located in the clubhouse. It will be open for food and beverage needs beginning at 7:45 a.m. each day of the championship. In addition, snacks, fruit and water will be available near both the 1st and 10th tees.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

If you must withdraw, notify the NGA office immediately. Please call Ben Vigil at (402) 505-4653, ext. 105. Failure to comply may render you liable to disqualification from future NGA Championships.

CADDIES

A player may provide her own caddie. Caddies are prohibited from taking transportation during the round. *Exception: A player may not use a parent or quardian as a caddie during the championship.*

PERSONAL APPEARANCE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing.

SCORE POSTING

All scores will be posted for handicap purposes. Players should not post these scores individually.

RUNNER-UP: Silver medal and a crystal trophy.

TOP TEN: Bronze Medal.
