The core purpose of Youth on Course is to provide juniors with access to life-changing opportunities through golf.

Youth on Course began in Northern California and has spread to nearly 30 regions in the United States over the past few years. For \$5 or less, members can play year-round at one of our participating YOC facilities or use their card to play any YOC course outside Nebraska.

YOC is based on the following formula. The NGA negotiates a preferred junior golf rate of \$10 with each participating facility. YOC members pay \$5 or less each round they play, with the NGF subsidizing the difference between the preferred rate and the YOC member payment for each of those rounds.

YOC creates accessibility, availability and affordability while encouraging a passion for the game. As confidence and skill level grow, so does the child's love of golf. Over 1,600 juniors participated in the FORE! program in 2018 with over 5,000 rounds subsidized.
