NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for NGA Championships)

Deciding Ties:

In case of a tie for first place in the individual competition, concerned players shall immediately play-off hole-by-hole until a winner is determined. The play-off rotation will be holes #18-16-17-18, unless otherwise notified by the Committee. In case of a tie for first place in the team competition, the winner will be decided according to the NGA's Fall Junior Series Playoff Policy, by comparing the non-counting player's score from each team. If the teams are still tied, refer to the policy for further tie-breaking.

Drop Zones:

<u>Hole #10 Ball Unplayable</u> - If a ball is deemed unplayable between the blue stakes behind the green on Hole #10, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke: 1) Take relief under Rule 19.2; or 2) As an extra option, drop the original ball or another ball in the closest of the two <u>dropping zones marked "DZ"</u>. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.

Ground Under Repair:

Young trees identified with a well at their base are ground under repair, even though not so defined by white lines.

Flower and Plant beds are ground under repair, even though not so defined by white lines.

Obstructions:

Artificially surfaced roads and paths include those surfaced with crushed rock, gravel, asphalt and mulch.

<u>Flower and plant beds enclosed by cart paths</u> or adjacent to immovable obstructions are deemed to be part of the immovable obstruction.

Immovable obstructions within or adjacent to each other are to be treated as a single immovable obstruction.

<u>White stakes</u> used to define out of bounds along the left of hole #9 are deemed to be immovable obstructions during play of any other hole.

<u>White stakes</u> used to define out of bounds along the left of hole #18 are deemed to be immovable obstructions during play of any other hole.

Out of Bounds:

Out of Bounds is defined by the perimeter fence in addition to white stakes and lines.

Hole #1 - Out of Bounds is defined by the road along the right. A ball is out of bounds when it lies on or beyond the road.

Hole #2 - Out of Bounds is defined by the white line behind the putting green.

Hole #9 - The white stakes along the left side are out of bounds during play of the 9th hole only.

Hole #18 - The white stakes along the left side are out of bounds during play of the 18th hole only.

Scoring Area:

<u>Scoring Area</u> – The scoring area is defined as the area near the scoring tables.

Teeing Area:

The NGA tee-markers define the teeing area for the competition.

Transportation:

During the round, a player must not ride on any form of motorized transportation except as authorized or later approved by the Committee. <u>Except</u> that a player may accept transportation from #9 putting green to #10 teeing area and from #18 putting green to #1 teeing area. A player who will play, or has played, under penalty of stroke and distance is always authorized to ride on motorized transportation.
