CHAMPIONSHIP WEB SITE

CADDIES & CARTS

You may carry your own bag or provide your own caddie. Automotive transportation (cart) is permitted. If a player has not pre-registered for a cart he should contact Fremont Golf Club pro shop (402) 721-6642 to make a reservation because sufficient carts may not be available. Carts will be limited to no more than two carts per group. Use of push carts is also permitted.

DRESS CODE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a team that does not comply. **No jeans** or jean shorts.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

The grill room will be open for food and beverage service each day of the championship.

FOOTWEAR

Fremont Golf Club is a spikeless club and, therefore, spiked shoes will not be allowed. Penalty for breach of the spikeless rule is disqualification.

FORMAT

Stroke Play - 36-holes. Following the first round, the championship field will be separated into flights based upon first round score. All contestants remain eligible for the overall title of Mid-Amateur champion regardless of flight.

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, First Round, 18-holes. 9:00 a.m. Shotgun

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 29, Second Round, 18-holes. 8:00 a.m. 1/10 tee

Lowest score for 36-holes will be champion. A tie for first place in the Championship flight only will be played off immediately, hole-by-hole, until a winner is determined.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

If you must withdraw, notify the NGA office immediately. Please call Justin Ahrens at (402) 505-4653, ext. 104 or at (402) 380-1916 beginning Friday, September 27. Failure to comply may render you liable to disqualification from future NGA Championships.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Practice areas will open one hour prior to the first start time. Range balls are complimentary and will be available on the practice field.

PRACTICE ROUNDS

To make arrangements for a practice round at a time convenient to the club contact Fremont Golf Club at (402) 721-6642. Practice round rate is \$26.75 if walking and \$46 if taking a cart.

REGISTRATION

Registration will be located just outside the entrance to the Golf Shop beginning at 7:30 a.m. Saturday, September 28. Players are required to check in prior to starting play to receive necessary announcements.

PRIZES

WINNER: Custody of championship trophy, gold medal, championship money clip.

RUNNER-UP: Crystal trophy.

SPECTATORS

Spectators are allowed and encouraged.

STARTING TIMES

See the pairings link on the championship web site following the close of entries for your assigned starting tee for round one. Round two starting times will be available following round one. It is your responsibility to be present at your assigned starting tee and ready to play at the assigned time.

SCORE POSTING

All scores will be posted for handicap purposes. Players should not post these scores individually.
