NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Terms of the Competition for NGA Championships)

Abnormal Course Conditions:

<u>Flower and Plant Beds</u> are deemed to be ground under repair even though not so defined by white lines. *Exception: Flower and Plant Beds* surrounding trees are deemed to be through the green, therefore, no relief without penalty.

<u>Hole #9</u> – The mulched bed and cart path surrounding the Performance Center have the same immovable obstruction status as the Performance Center. The entire area is considered one immovable obstruction.

<u>Hole #14</u> - The mulched bed and cart path surrounding the beverage station have the same immovable obstruction status as the beverage station. The entire area is considered one immovable obstruction.

<u>Hole #16</u> – Turf Nursery located right of the green is ground under repair from which <u>play is prohibited</u>. If interference exists, relief must be taken. Such nursery is not defined, but it constitutes all of the area cut at approximately putting green height or less.

Hole #17 – The tennis court behind the green is an obstruction.

Dropping Zones:

<u>Hole #2 Integral Object</u> - If a ball is in the integral object behind the putting green on Hole #2, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke: 1) Take relief under Rule 19.2; or 2) As an extra option, drop the original ball or another ball in the nearest dropping zone marked <u>"DZ"</u>. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.

<u>Hole #5 Red Penalty Area</u> - If a ball is in the red penalty area on Hole #5, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke: 1) Take relief under Rule 17.1; or 2) As an extra option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone marked <u>"DZ" located behind the green on #5</u>. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.

<u>Hole #9 Abnormal Course Condition</u> - If a ball is in the abnormal course condition left of the putting green on Hole #9, the player has these free relief options: 1) Take relief under Rule 16.1; or 2) As an extra option, drop the original ball or another ball in the nearest dropping zone marked <u>"DZ"</u>. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.

Integral Objects:

Hole #2 - The area between the blue stakes behind #2 green is deemed to be an integral object. No relief without penalty.

<u>Blue Paint Dots</u> - Used to define the depth on each putting green and deemed to be an integral object, therefore, no relief without penalty.

Out of Bounds:

Out of Bounds is defined by the perimeter fence in addition to white lines and stakes.

Concrete Bases of Boundary Fence Posts – are part of the fence and thus not an obstruction.

<u>Hole #4</u> – Out of Bounds is defined by the curbing of both the parking lot along the left side of the green and the road behind the green. A ball is out of bounds when it lies beyond the curbing even though it might lie on another part of the golf course.

<u>Hole #6</u> – Out of Bounds is defined by the curbing of the parking lot along the left side and the white line on the road behind the green. A ball is out of bounds when it lies beyond the curbing even though it might lie on another part of the golf course.

Hole #8 - Out of Bounds is defined by the wood fence around the maintenance area in addition to white stakes.

<u>Hole #9</u> - Out of Bounds is defined by the wood fence around the maintenance area, the white stakes along the left, and the curbing of the parking lot and the road behind the green.

Hole #18 - Out of Bounds is defined by the curbing of the parking lot behind the green.

Penalty Areas:

Holes #13, #14 and #15 - The portion of the pond on Hole #14 that is marked as a yellow penalty area plays as a red penalty area during play of holes #13 and #5.

Play-off:

A tie for first place will be decided by a hole-by-hole play-off immediately following play.

Scoring Area:

Scoring Area - A scorecard is deemed to be returned when the player and their marker have verbally verified hole-by-hole scores with the scoring official and left the roped scoring area.

Teeing Area:

<u>Red NGA Tee-Markers</u> define the teeing area for the Championship Division; <u>Blue NWAGA Tee Markers</u> define the teeing area for the Non-Championship Division.

Temporary Immovable Obstructions:

<u>Tee Signs, Water Coolers/Stands and Tents</u> are deemed to be Temporary Immovable Obstructions. Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect. Relief may be taken on either side.
