CHAMPIONSHIP WEB SITE

Complete championship information is available at the official Nebraska Four-Ball Championship web site nebgolf.org/nebraskafourball/. Included are links to tournament history, course set-up, groupings and starting times, real-time scoring updates and media.

PRACTICE ROUNDS

To make arrangements for a practice round at a time convenient to the club contact Fremont Golf Club at (402) 721-6642. Practice round rate is \$26.75 if walking and \$46.75 if taking a cart.

PLAYER REGISTRATION

Registration will be located in front of the entrance to the pro shop one hour prior to the first start time each day of the championship. Players **ARE REQUIRED** to check in prior to starting play each day for COVID-19 screening assessment before they will be allowed access to the facility.

CARTS

Automotive transportation (cart) is permitted. Cart fees are included in the entry and will be available for pickup in the cart staging area. **One (1) cart per side (team) will be available.** Single rider carts will not be available. Pull/push carts are permitted.

SCORING

Scorecards will not be used during the championship. Digital (online) scoring will be used in place of scorecards through the USGA Tournament Management (USGA TM) app. Players are asked to download the USGA TM app prior to the start of their first round. Complete instructions on how to download the USGA TM app, login, and keep score will be sent to players prior to the start of the championship. Upon completion of the round players will enter the designated scoring area to review and verify their scores verbally with the scoring official.

ON-COURSE AMENITIES (WATER & SNACKS)

Bottled water will be available for players and caddies on #1 and #10 tees. Snacks, i.e. fruit, energy bars, etc. will not be available anywhere on the golf course. Players are encouraged to bring their own water bottle and snacks for consumption during their round.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Practice areas will open at 8:00 a.m. Saturday and Sunday. Range balls are complimentary and will be available on the practice field.

FORMAT

36-hole stroke play competition. In Four-Ball stroke play, two competitors play as partners, each playing his own ball. The lower score of the partners is the score for the hole.

DIVISIONS

Following the first round, the field will be separated into flights based upon first round score. All teams remain eligible for the overall title but are restricted to merchandise prizes within their flight.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

If you must withdraw, notify the NGA office immediately. Please call Justin Ahrens at (402) 505-4653, ext. 104 or at (402) 380-1916 beginning Friday, September 25. Failure to comply may render you liable to disqualification from future NGA Championships.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

The NGA will host a buffet following play Sunday. In addition, the clubhouse will be open for food and beverage service each day. Players may pay cash or use a credit card for purchases.

DRESS CODE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a team that does not comply. **No jeans** or jean shorts.

FOOTWEAR

Fremont Golf Club is a spikeless club and, therefore, spiked shoes will not be allowed. Penalty for breach of the spikeless rule is disqualification.

PERSONAL EFFECTS

Please take care of your valuables. Neither Awarii Dunes Golf Club nor the NGA can assume responsibility for articles lost or stolen.

STARTING TIMES

See the pairings link on the championship web site following the close of entries for your assigned starting tee and time. Final round groupings and starting times will be available following the first round. It is your responsibility to be present at your assigned starting tee and ready to play at the assigned time.

SCORE POSTING

All scores will be posted for handicap purposes. Players should not post these scores individually.

PRIZES

WINNERS: Individual gold medals, trophies, championship money clips and custody of championship trophy, subject to such conditions as the NGA may establish.
