PRACTICE ROUNDS

Indian Creek is a public facility and is accessible for golf prior to the event at the normal green fee rate (\$35 Monday-Thursday, \$43 Friday-Sunday). Please call the golf shop at (402) 289-0900, ext 5. to make a tee time reservation.

CADDIES

Caddies are prohibited. Non-motorized push carts are permitted.

TRANSPORTATION

Automotive transportation is prohibited. Participants must walk at all times unless otherwise approved by the Committee.

PLAYER REGISTRATION

All players must register prior to play each day of competition. Registration will be conveniently located on the practice range from 7 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. Each morning participants will be required to verbally answer COVID-19 related screening questions in order to participate. Please see page one for details.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Practice facilities will be available to players no sooner than one hour prior to their round each day of the competition. Each player will be limited to one bag of range balls prior to their round with range stations spaced to accommodate social distancing.

RULES DOCUMENTS AND HOLE LOCATIONS

All competition documents, including Notice to Competitors, Pace of Play Policy and the NGA's Local Rules & Terms of the Competition is available [under the information tab on the competition web site](#). Hole Location sheets will be posted in this area of the web site as well the day prior to each round. Players are encouraged to review these materials prior to play. Printed copies of these documents will be available in the starter's box for pick-up prior to each round.

ELECTRONIC SCORING

Official scoring will be done electronically through our USGA Tournament Management (USGA TM) app. Players are asked to install this app on their mobile device prior to the start of qualifying. **Complete instructions are included on the last page of this memo.** Paper scorecards will be distributed for players to use during the round but the official scorecard review and verification process will be done verbally following each round.

ON-COURSE WATER

Bottled water will be available throughout the competition on both 1 and 10 tees.

SPECTATORS

There are no limitations on spectators but they are asked to be responsible with regards to social distancing. Spectator carts are permitted.

FORMAT

This championship is comprised of two divisions (Men's and Women's). Both divisions will play 54-holes of stroke play with two continuous rounds conducted Saturday and one round Sunday. The lowest score in each Division will determine the winner. Ties for first place, regardless of division, will be broken by a hole-by-hole play-off.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE SERVICE—SATURDAY HOSTED GRAB AND GO LUNCH

The clubhouse will be available for general food and beverage purchases beginning at 7 a.m. each day of the competition. A grab and go lunch will be provided to players on their assigned starting tee between rounds Saturday.

DRESS CODE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply. Absolutely No Traditional Metal Spikes.

PRIZES

Men's Division: Champion – trophy and gold medal; Runner-Up – trophy and silver medal.

Women's Division: Champion – trophy and gold medal; Runner-Up – trophy and silver medal.

GROUPINGS AND STARTING TIMES

Groupings and starting times for Saturday's play (Rounds One and Two) will be available Tuesday afternoon, October 6 through the competition web site (link below). Saturday's 36-holes of play will be continuous. Pairings for Sunday's final round will be posted immediately following play Saturday based on score and order of return. The leaders in the Men's Division will go last off hole 1, the leaders in the Women's Division will go last off hole 10.

USGA Tournament Management (USGA TM) Mobile Scoring App

Official scoring will be done electronically through our USGA Tournament Management (USGA TM) app. Players are asked to install this app on their mobile device prior to the start of round one. Paper scorecards will be distributed on the starting tee for players to use during the round but the official scorecard review and verification process will be done verbally following the round based on information submitted via the scoring app.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Go to your app store on your Android or iPhone. Search "USGA Tournament Management". Download the app (blue icon).
2. When you receive your printed scorecard, open the mobile app on your phone.
3. Enter the GGID found on your printed scorecard.
4. Click on your name.
5. Enter the correct score for all of the players.
6. After scores are entered for a hole, click "Save Scores". You will be directed to the next hole.
7. To view the leaderboard, click on "Leaderboard" on the top right.
