PRACTICE ROUNDS

Each player is entitled to one practice round, free-of-charge (walking), the week prior to the championship. Tee times are based on availability, and include the restrictions below, so please call the Fremont GC golf shop at (402) 721-6642 and reserve your time as soon as possible.

Practice Round Restrictions

Monday, July 26 – Available after 1:30 p.m.
Tuesday, July 27 and Wednesday, July 28 – Available anytime
Thursday, July 29 and Friday, July 30 – No Availability
Saturday, July 31 and Sunday, August 1 – Available after 1:30 p.m.

REGISTRATION

Players are required to check in prior to their first round starting time. Registration will be located just outside the golf shop beginning at 7 a.m. Monday.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Practice areas will open at 7 a.m. each day of the championship. Range balls will be available on the range. The practice range at Fremont GC is located on the north side of the golf course. In addition, Fremont GC features a short game practice area near the range, as well as three practice greens near the 1st and 10th tees.

STARTING TIMES

Starting times for Round One for Girls, and Rounds One and Two for Boys will be posted following the deadline. See the pairings tab on the championship web site for your assigned starting tee and time. It is your responsibility to be present at your assigned starting tee and ready to play at the assigned time.

CADDIES

A player may provide his/her own caddie. Caddies are prohibited from taking transportation during the round. **Exception: A player may not use a parent or guardian as a caddie during the championship.**

SCORING

Scorecards will be used during the championship. Either one player or caddie in each group will be required to enter hole-by-hole scores digitally via an electronic device (cell phone) through the USGA Tournament Management (USGA TM) app. Players are asked to download the USGA TM app prior to the start of their first round. Complete instructions on how to download the USGA TM app, login, and keep score will be at the starter's table. Upon completion of the round players will enter the designated scoring area to review, verify and sign their scorecards.

FORMAT

A) Stroke Play – Girls—36 Holes; Boys—54 Holes.

MONDAY A.M., AUGUST 2, First Round, 18-holes. (Girls)

MONDAY A.M. & P.M., AUGUST 2, First Round, 18-holes. (Boys)

TUESDAY A.M. & P.M., AUGUST 3, Second Round, 18-holes. (Boys)

The low 40 scores and ties will advance to play the boys' Final Round on Wednesday.

TUESDAY P.M., AUGUST 3, Final Round, 18-holes. (Girls)

Girls' Lowest Score for 36-holes will be champion. A tie for first place will be played off hole-by-hole until a champion is determined.

WEDNESDAY A.M., AUGUST 4, Final Round, 18-holes. (Boys)

Boys' Lowest Score for 54 holes will be champion. A tie for first place will be played off hole-by-hole until a champion is determined.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

The 19th Hole will be open for food and beverage needs beginning at 7 a.m. each day of the championship. Water stations will be available on-course. In addition, fruit and snacks will be available on the starting tees.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

If you must withdraw, notify the NGA office immediately. Please call Ben Vigil at (402) 505-4653, ext. 105. Failure to comply may render you liable to disqualification from future NGA Championships.

PERSONAL EFFECTS

PERSONAL APPEARANCE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing.

SPECTATORS

Spectators are allowed. Carts will be allowed, based on availability, for spectators to rent through the golf shop at Fremont GC.

SCORE POSTING

All scores will be posted for handicap purposes. Players should not post these scores individually.

PRIZES

WINNER: Custody of championship trophy, gold medal and a NGA trophy to keep.

RUNNER-UP: Silver medal and a NGA trophy.

TOP TEN: Bronze Medal.
