FORMAT:	Stroke play competition conducted over 18-holes.		
QUALIFYING PLACES:	20 entrants competing for one qualifying place and two alternate positions.

PRACTICE ROUNDS:	Practice rounds are available at a time convenient to Fremont Golf Club at a rate of \$45 plus tax (includes cart). If desired, those entered may contact the golf shop at (402) 721-6642 to make arrangements.		
REGISTRATION:	On the qualifying day, players are requested to check in upon arrival at the registration table located just outside the clubhouse. Registration will open at 7 a.m. and be available until all players have registered.		
PRACTICE AREAS:	Practice areas will open at 7 a.m. on the day of qualifying. Range balls will be available for player's on the practice range.		
LOCKER ROOM:	Use of the locker room is permitted but individual lockers are not available.		
FOOD AND BEVERAGE:	Food and beverage service will be available in the 19th hole beginning at 7 a.m. Coolers will be located on the golf-course with bottled water and snacks for players and caddies.		
ACCOMMODATIONS:	A special rate has been secured at the Holiday Inn Express in Fremont, (402) 753-3850, for Sunday August 8th. Reference Nebraska Golf Association when booking your room to receive the reduced rate of \$118.95.		
PLAY-OFF:	In the event of a tie for the qualifying place or two alternate positions, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff to determine place winners immediately following the qualifying round.		

- **PRIZES:** Lowest score - silver medal; if a tie, duplicate medals will be awarded. DRESS CODE: Players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Shorts are permitted. **FOOTWEAR:** A player must not wear shoes with traditional spikes or spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal will come in contact with the course. **DRIVERS/GOLF BALLS:** The Local Rule for Conforming Driver Heads is in effect, See Model Local Rule G-1. The Local Rule requiring that all golf balls used be on the List of Conforming Golf Balls is in effect. See Model Local Rule G-3. Please check the USGA web site for a list of approved golf balls and drivers. The "One Ball Rule" is in effect. See Model Local Rule G-4. **GROOVE STANDARDS:** It is a requirement that a player's clubs conform to the groove and punch mark specifications in the Equipment Rules. See Model Local Rule G-2. An Equipment Database is found on the USGA web site. The use of electronic distance measuring devices, to measure distance only, is **RANGEFINDERS:** allowed (subject to certain requirements). **CADDIES:** A player may provide his own caddie. If he wishes to have the host club furnish a caddie, he should ask the Official in Charge because sufficient caddies may not be available. Pull/push carts are permitted. CARTS: While the player and the player's caddie may use a golf cart, there is a "one-
  - CARTS: While the player and the player's caddle may use a golf cart, there is a "oneseat" policy in effect meaning the player and the player's caddle cannot ride in a golf cart at the same time. If two players in a group request a golf cart, only one cart will be distributed to that group. If three players request a golf cart, two carts will be distributed. Link here for the complete policy.

- **PACE OF PLAY:** Participants must play without undue delay and in accordance with pace of play guidelines established by the NGA <u>attached here</u>.
- **EVACUATION PLAN:** In the event of a discontinuance of play during the qualifier, players must adhere to the evacuation plan <u>attached here</u>.
- **COVID GUIDELINES:** The qualifying web site includes information on any guidelines associated with this qualifier. <u>You can also access them by linking here</u>.
- **ELECTRONIC SCORING:** To assist with real-time scoring, a player or caddie in each group will be required to enter hole-by-hole scores into the <u>USGA TM/Golf Genius app</u>.
- SPECTATORS:Spectators are allowed and encouraged to follow a golfer. Per USGA<br/>guidelines, the use of golf carts for spectators is prohibited.
