# **NOTICE TO COMPETITORS**

(This information supplements the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2021 NGA Championships & Events)

1. <u>Deciding Ties:</u> In the event of a tie for first place in a division, a hole-by-hole play-off will determine the champion unless otherwise notified by the Committee. Playoff Holes - #18, #18, #10-#18.

# 2. Teeing Ground:

- a. Championship Division Red NGA Tee Markers define the teeing area.
- b. Tournament Division White NGA Tee Markers define the teeing area.
- 3. <u>Scoring Area:</u> A player's scorecard is deemed to be returned when it has been given to the scoring official and the player has left the scoring area defined by blue dots.

#### 4. Out of Bounds:

a. Out of Bounds is defined by white stakess in addition to white lines, white paint dots, fence posts and chain link fences.

### 5. Penalty Areas:

- a. **Dropping Zones:** If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in one of the defined penalty areas below the player may proceed (i) under Rule 17.1 or (ii) as an extra option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke in the prescribed dropping zone. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.
  - Hole 6 Yellow Penalty Area DZ located in the fairway.
  - Hole 17 Yellow Penalty Area DZ located on forward tee.

#### 6. Ground Under Repair:

- a. Decorative Flower and Plant Beds. When enclosed by cart paths or adjacent to immovable obstructions they are treated as a single abnormal course condition.
- **7.** Movable Obstructions include, but are not limited to:
  - **a.** Staking and roping, NGA tee signs, NGA trash cans, NGA water coolers and stands.
- 8. <u>Immovable Obstructions</u> include, but are not limited to:
  - a. Decorative rocks.
  - b. Tree Bags.
  - c. Artificially Surfaced Roads and Paths including those surfaced with crushed brick, gravel or asphalt.
  - d. Immovable obstructions adjacent to, within or abutting each other, such as artificially surfaced paths (including decorative areas enclosed by these paths), curbing, walls, steps and drains, are considered a single obstruction.
  - e. Permanent restrooms and structures, including adjacent and surrounding artificially surfaced paths, patios, and decorative plantings, are considered a single obstruction.

# 9. Temporary Immovable Obstructions:

- a. NGA tents, grandstand frames, and grandstands.
- b. **Relief on Either Side:** Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect and includes any temporary immovable obstruction installed for the competition. If a player has either physical interference or line of sight interference from any TIO and is entitled to relief, as an additional option, he or she may take relief on the other side of the TIO along the arc without penalty. When taking relief on the other side of the TIO, the player may only take relief under the TIO Local Rule, not Rule 16.1.

- 11. Final Decisions on Any Disputed Points will be made by Justin Ahrens, Craig Ames, and Ben Vigil.
