CHAMPIONSHIP WEB SITE

Complete championship information is available at the official Nebraska Mid-Amateur Championship web site nebgolf.org/nebraskamidamateurchampionship. Included are links to tournament history, course set-up, groupings and starting times, real-time scoring updates and media.

PRACTICE ROUNDS

Practice rounds can be arranged by contacting the pro shop at Norfolk CC, (402) 379-1188. The fee is \$35 (walking) and \$53 (including cart). Available at a time convenient to the club beginning August 1st. *Exception: No practice rounds available after 12:00 p.m. on Tuesdays.

PLAYER REGISTRATION

Registration will be located in front of the entrance to the pro shop one hour prior to the first start time of Round One.

CADDIES

Caddies are permitted.

CARTS

Automotive transportation (cart) is permitted. If a player has not pre-registered for a cart he should contact the NGA office to make a reservation because sufficient carts may not be available. Single rider carts will not be available. Only two (2) carts per group will be allowed. Under no circumstances will three (3) carts be allowed in a group. Players should expect to be paired up for cart use. Caddies may be asked to walk if carts are occupied by players.

Pull/push carts are permitted.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Practice areas will open one hour prior to the first start time. Range balls are complimentary and will be available on the practice field.

SCORING

Scorecards will be distributed during the championship. One player or caddie in each group will be required to enter hole-by-hole scores digitally. Players are asked to download the USGA TM app prior to the start of their first round. Complete instructions on how to download the USGA TM app, login, and keep score will be sent to players prior to the start of the championship. Upon completion of the round players will enter the designated scoring area to review, verify and sign scorecards.

ON-COURSE AMENITIES (WATER & SNACKS)

Bottled water will be available for players and caddies on holes #1 & #10 tees. Snacks, i.e. fruit, energy bars, etc. will be available on #1 and #10 tees.

SPECTATORS

Spectators are allowed and encouraged. SPECTATOR CARTS WILL NOT be available during the championship.

FORMAT

Stroke Play - 36-holes. Following the first round, the championship field will be separated into flights based upon first round score. All contestants remain eligible for the overall title of Mid-Amateur champion regardless of flight.

SATURDAY, AUGUST 28, First Round, 18-holes. 8:00 a.m. 1/10 tee

SUNDAY, AUGUST 29, Second Round, 18-holes. 8:00 a.m. 1/10 tee

Lowest score for 36-holes will be champion. A tie for first place in the Championship flight only will be played off immediately, hole-by-hole, until a winner is determined.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

If you must withdraw, notify the NGA office immediately. Please call Justin Ahrens at (402) 505-4653, ext. 104 or at (402) 380-1916 beginning Friday, August 27. Failure to comply may render you liable to disqualification from future NGA Championships.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

The clubhouse will be open for food and beverage service each day of the championship.

DRESS CODE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a team that does not comply. **No jeans** or jean shorts.

FOOTWEAR

Norfolk Country Club is a spikeless club and, therefore, spiked shoes will not be allowed. Penalty for breach of the spikeless rule is disqualification.

PERSONAL EFFECTS

Please take care of your valuables. Neither Norfolk Country Club nor the NGA can assume responsibility for articles lost or stolen.

PRIZES

Merchandise Prizes will be announced following Round One.

CHAMPION: Gold medal, trophy, championship money clip and custody of championship trophy, subject to such conditions as the NGA may establish.

RUNNER-UP: Trophy; if a tie, duplicates will be awarded.

STARTING TIMES

See the pairings link on the championship web site following the close of entries for your assigned starting tee for round one. Round two starting times will be available following round one. It is your responsibility to be present at your assigned starting tee and ready to play at the assigned time.

SCORE POSTING

All scores will be posted for handicap purposes. Players should not post these scores individually.
