PRACTICE ROUNDS

To make arrangements for a practice round at a time convenient to Fremont Golf Club please contact the Pro Shop at (402) 721-6642. Cost of the practice round is \$25+tax (walking) or \$48+tax (riding).

REGISTRATION

Players are required to check in prior to their first round starting time. Registration will be located just outside the golf shop beginning at 12 p.m. Saturday.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Practice areas will open one hour prior to the first start time each day of the championship. Range balls will be available on the range. The practice range at Fremont GC is located on the north side of the golf course. In addition, Fremont GC features a short game practice area near the range, as well as three practice greens near the 1st and 10th tees.

<u>CARTS</u>

Automotive transportation (cart) is permitted. Players will need to pay for their cart prior to the start of each round. <u>Only</u> two (2) carts per group will be allowed. Under no circumstances will three (3) carts be allowed in a group. Players should expect to be paired up for cart use. Caddies may be asked to walk if carts are occupied by players.

Pull/push carts are permitted.

CADDIES

A player may provide his/her own caddie.

STARTING TIMES

Starting times for Round One will be posted following the deadline. See the pairings tab on the championship web site for your assigned starting tee and time. It is your responsibility to be present at your assigned starting tee and ready to play at the assigned time.

SCORING

Scorecards will be used during the championship. Either one player or caddie in each group will be required to enter hole by-hole scores digitally via an electronic device (cell phone) through the USGA Tournament Management (USGA TM) app. Players are asked to download the USGA TM app prior to the start of their first round. Complete instructions on how to download the USGA TM app, login, and keep score will be at the starter's table. Upon completion of the round players will enter the designated scoring area to review, verify and sign their scorecards.

FORMAT

Stroke Play – 36 Holes. Following the first round, the championship field will be separated into flights based upon first round score. All contestants remain eligible for the overall title of Women's Mid-Amateur champion regardless of flight.

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, First Round, 18-holes. SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, Final Round, 18-holes.

Lowest score for 36-holes will be champion. A tie for first place in the Championship flight only will be played off immediately, hole-by-hole, until a winner is determined.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

The Grill Room will be open for food and beverage needs each day of the championship. Water stations will be available on-course. In addition, fruit and snacks will be available on the starting tee.

PLAYER RECEPTION & LUNCHEON

A hosted player reception will be held in the Grill Room following play on Saturday and a hosted player luncheon will be held in the Grill Room following play on Sunday.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

If you must withdraw, notify the NGA office immediately. Please call Justin Ahrens at (402) 505-4653, ext. 104 or at (402) 380-1916 beginning Friday, September 17. Failure to comply may render you liable to disqualification from future NGA Championships.

PERSONAL EFFECTS

Please take care of your valuables. Neither Fremont Golf Club nor the NGA can assume responsibility for articles lost or stolen.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing.

SPECTATORS

Spectators are allowed. Carts will be allowed, based on availability, for spectators to rent through the golf shop at Fremont GC.

SCORE POSTING

All scores will be posted for handicap purposes. Players should not post these scores individually.

<u>PRIZES</u>

Merchandise prizes will be announced following Round One.

WINNER: Custody of championship trophy, gold medal and a NGA trophy to keep. RUNNER-UP: Silver medal and a NGA trophy.
