Nebraska Golf Association Junior Point Evaluation System

To be used in determining exemptions and selecting the Nebraska Junior Cup Team, NGA Junior All-Star Team, and the Nebraska Junior Amateur Golfer of the Year.

Part One – Written Portion

The purpose of the Nebraska Golf Association (NGA) junior point evaluation system is to establish objective criteria by which the NGA Junior Committee can judge the performance of junior golfers who participate in state and/or national tournaments beginning **after March 31 and conclude prior to October 16**.

Tournament Participation Limit

In order to prevent unfair advantages of one player over others, simply by playing in more tournaments, each player will only be allocated points based on his best six tournament finishes. At least one of the player's six point finishes must be from a Nebraska Golf Association Championship.

Tournaments included in the NGA Junior Point Evaluation are limited to those events listed on pages 2, 3 & 4. Each is pre-assigned a point level. In addition, those events listed on Page 5 of the NGA's Men's Point Evaluation System (with the exception of the USGA championships on that page) will also be included. A junior who competes in those competitions will receive the full points earned based on the chart on that page. If a player competes in a national event not included on any of those pages, the player may submit a written request (send to <u>bvigil@nebgolf.org</u>) for the NGA Junior Committee to review the event and potentially award points in an equitable manner.

Nebraska Junior Cup Team

The selection of the annual 8-man Nebraska Junior Cup Team will be based upon the NGA Junior Point Standings published July 28 (following the Nebraska Amateur). Those golfers ranked in the top six will automatically qualify for the team. The Nebraska Golf Association Board of Directors has granted the NGA Junior Committee the right to select the remainder of the team, including replacements for qualifiers.

NGA Junior All-Star Team and Junior Player of the Year Awards

The selection of the five boys to the annual NGA Junior All-Star Team and Nebraska Junior Golfer of the Year award will be based upon NGA Junior Point Standings published October 15. In order to be eligible for these postseason awards, the player must play in at least one of the NGA's championships.
