CHAMPIONSHIP WEB SITE

Complete championship information is available at the official Nebraska Senior Amateur Championship web site nebgolf.org/nebraskasenioram/. Included are links to tournament history, course set-up, groupings and starting times, real-time scoring updates and media.

PRACTICE ROUNDS

Can be arranged by contacting the golf shop at Champions Run (402) 498-8989. The fee is \$70 (including cart/range). Practice rounds will be available May 15-June 28 at a time convenient to the club. No practice rounds available before 12:00 p.m. on weekends or holidays. *Note: Only one practice round per player allowed and cannot be reserved more than 5 days in advance.

PLAYER REGISTRATION

Registration will be located in the bag drop area beginning at 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 29th. Players **ARE REQUIRED** to check in prior to starting play.

CADDIES

Caddies are permitted.

CARTS

Automotive transportation (cart) is permitted. If a player has not pre-registered for a cart he should contact the NGA office to make a reservation because sufficient carts may not be available. Maximum of two (2) carts per group will be allowed. Under no circumstances will three (3) carts be allowed in a group. Players should expect to be paired up for cart use. Caddies may be asked to walk if carts are occupied by players.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Practice areas will open one hour prior to the first start time each day of the championship. Range balls are complimentary and will be available on the practice field.

FORMAT

Stroke Play – 36 Holes.

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 29, First Round, 18-holes.

THURSDAY, JUNE 30, Second Round, 18-holes.

CHAMPIONSHIP: Golfers 50-57 and those 58 and older that elect to play from the championship tees will be eligible for the championship division.

AGE DIVISIONS: In addition to the championship, players will compete in both gross and net competitions in the following age groups: 50-57; 58-64; 65-71 and 72 & over.

SCORING

Scorecards will be used during the championship. Either one player or caddie in each group will be required to enter hole-by-hole scores digitally via an electronic device (cell phone) through the Golf Genius app. Players are asked to download the Golf Genius app prior to the start of their first round. Complete instructions on how to download the app, login, and keep score will be at the starter's table. Upon completion of the round players will enter the designated scoring area to review, verify and sign their scorecards.

PRIZES

CHAMPIONSHIP DIVISION

WINNER: Gold Medal, championship money clip, trophy and custody of the Nebraska Senior Amateur Championship trophy.

AGE DIVISIONS

WINNER OF EACH DIVISION (50-57; 58-64; 65-71 and 72 & over): Trophy GROSS MERCHANDISE PRIZES: To Be Determined

SPECTATORS

Spectators are allowed. **SPECTATOR CARTS WILL ONLY** be available based on availability after all players, NGA staff and volunteers are accommodated.

ON-COURSE AMENITIES (WATER & SNACKS)

Bottled water will be available for players and caddies on #1 and #10 tees, as well as, #5 and #13 tee. Snacks, i.e. fruit, energy bars, etc. will be available on #1 and #10 tees.

PLAYER LUNCHEONS

The NGA will host lunch for all contestants following play Thursday.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

The clubhouse will be open for food & beverage service each day of the championship. The club accepts credit card and club reciprocals as method of payment. No cash accepted.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

If you must withdraw, notify the NGA office immediately. Please call Justin Ahrens at (402) 505-4653, ext. 104 or at (402) 380-1916. Failure to comply may render you liable to disqualification from future NGA Championships.

STARTING TIMES

Round one groupings and starting times are available through the championship web site or by linking below. Round two starting times will be based on first round gross scores within divisions. It is your responsibility to be at your assigned starting tee early. An official clock will be present on the 1st and 10th tee with unofficial clocks in all practice areas.

PERSONAL EFFECTS

Please take care of your valuables. Neither Champions Run nor the NGA can assume responsibility for articles lost or stolen.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply. Shorts may be worn but jeans or denim shorts are not allowed. No Metal Spikes.

SCORE POSTING

All scores will be posted for handicap purposes. Players should not post these scores individually.

COURSE SET-UP

The course set-up for each division is a hybrid of various yardages from the club's scorecard. We'll use the following tee colors when setting up the course for the championship:

NGA Red Tees - Age 50-57 & those 58 and older that wish to compete for the championship NGA White Tees - Age Division 58-64 White Tees - Age Division 65-71 Yellow Tees - Age Division 72 & Over

Golfers in the 58-64, 65-71, and 72+ divisions are eligible for the overall championship by competing from the NGA (Championship) tees. Golfers that choose this option remain eligible for prizes in their respective division. A play-off required to determine the winner of either the 58-64 or the 65+ divisions will take place from their assigned tournament tee (58-64 NGA white tees; 65-71 white tees; 72+ yellow tees).
