NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship Entry & Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2022 NGA Championships)

1. Ground Under Repair and Other Abnormal Course Conditions:

- a. Include but are not limited to:
 - i) Decorative flower beds.
 - ii) Young trees defined by stakes.

2. Immovable Obstructions:

- a. Include but are not limited to:
 - i) All artificially surfaced roads and paths surfaced with crushed rock, gravel, asphalt and mulch.
- b. Immovable obstructions adjacent to, within or abutting each other, such as artificially surfaced paths (including decorative areas enclosed by these paths), curbing, walls, steps and drains, are considered a single obstruction.

3. Movable Obstructions: Include but are not limited to:

- i) Staking and roping; trash cans; benches; and beverage coolers.

4. Penalty Areas:

- a. **Dropping Zones** - If a ball is in the following penalty areas, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:
 - i) proceed under Rule 17.1; or
 - ii) as an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone (marked "DZ") in the location below. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3:
 - Holes #2 & #11 Yellow Penalty Area - DZ located in the fairway.
 - Hole #12 Yellow Penalty Area - DZ located on a forward tee.

5. Out of Bounds:

- a. Defined by perimeter fences in addition to white stakes.
- b. Holes #2 & #3 - Defined by the course side edge of the brick pillars along the left side.
- c. Defined by the curbing of the street in the following areas. A ball is out of bounds when it lies beyond the curbing even though it may rest on another part of the course:
 - i) Hole #2 - Public street behind the putting green.
 - ii) Hole #4 - Public street behind the putting green.
 - iii) Hole #8 - Public street along the left side.
 - iv) Hole #9 - Public street along the left side.
 - v) Hole #18 - Public street behind the putting green.
- d. Holes #11, #13 & #14 - Defined by the course side edge of Maple Street along the right side.
- e. Hole #14 - Defined by the course side edge of 144th Street behind the hole.

6. Temporary Immovable Obstructions (TIOs): Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect. TIOs include but are not limited to: sponsor signs and tents.

- a. **Special Relief Procedure - Either Side Relief:**
 - i) If a player is allowed relief under the TIO Local Rule, the player may take relief without penalty on either side of the TIO.

7. Paint Dots and Lines Not Used for Course Marking: Blue paint dots are used to indicate the fronts and backs of putting greens and to define the scoring area. Free relief is NOT available.

8. Scoring Area: A player's scorecard is returned when it has been given to the scoring official and the player has left the scoring tent.

9. Teeing Area:

- a. Championship and 50-57 Age Division - Red NGA tee markers.
- b. 58-64 Age Division - Champions Run Blue tee markers.
- c. 65-71 Age Division - Champions Run White tee markers.
- d. 72 & Older Age Division - Champions Run Yellow tee markers.

10. Play-Off: A tie for first place will be decided by a hole-by-hole play-off beginning on Hole #17 immediately following play, unless otherwise notified by the Committee.

11. Pace of Play Review Committee: Craig Ames, Sam Oehm and Ben Vigil.

12. Final Decisions on Disputed Points will be made by Craig Ames, Sam Oehm and Ben Vigil.
