### NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship Entry & Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2022 NGA Championships)

### 1. Ground Under Repair and Other Abnormal Course Conditions:

- a. Include but are not limited to:
  - i) Decorative flower beds.
  - ii) Young trees defined by stakes.

#### 2. Immovable Obstructions:

- a. Include but are not limited to:
  - i) All artificially surfaced roads and paths surfaced with crushed rock, gravel, asphalt and mulch.
- b. Immovable obstructions adjacent to, within or abutting each other, such as artificially surfaced paths (including decorative areas enclosed by these paths), curbing, walls, steps and drains, are considered a single obstruction.

### 3. Movable Obstructions: Include but are not limited to:

i) Staking and roping; trash cans; benches; and beverage coolers.

### 4. Penalty Areas:

- a. **Dropping Zones** If a ball is in the following penalty areas, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:
  - i) proceed under Rule 17.1; or
  - ii) as an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone (marked "DZ") in the location below. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3:
    - Holes #2 & #11 Yellow Penalty Area DZ located in the fairway.
    - Hole #12 Yellow Penalty Area DZ located on a forward tee.

### 5. Out of Bounds:

- a. Defined by perimeter fences in addition to white stakes.
- b. Holes #2 & #3 Defined by the course side edge of the brick pillars along the left side.
- c. Defined by the curbing of the street in the following areas. A ball is out of bounds when it lies beyond the curbing even though it may rest on another part of the course:
  - i) Hole #2 Public street behind the putting green.
  - ii) Hole #4 Public street behind the putting green.
  - iii) Hole #8 Public street along the left side.
  - iv) Hole #9 Public street along the left side.
  - v) Hole #18 Public street behind the putting green.
- d. Holes #11, #13 & #14 Defined by the course side edge of Maple Street along the right side.
- e. Hole #14 Defined by the course side edge of 144<sup>th</sup> Street behind the hole.
- 6. Temporary Immovable Obstructions (TIOs): Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect. TIOs include but are not limited to: sponsor signs and tents.

# a. Special Relief Procedure - Either Side Relief:

- i) If a player is allowed relief under the TIO Local Rule, the player may take relief without penalty on either side of the TIO.
- 7. Paint Dots and Lines Not Used for Course Marking: Blue paint dots are used to indicate the fronts and backs of putting greens and to define the scoring area. Free relief is NOT available.
- 8. Scoring Area: A player's scorecard is returned when it has been given to the scoring official and the player has left the scoring tent.

# 9. Teeing Area:

- a. Championship and 50-57 Age Division Red NGA tee markers.
- b. 58-64 Age Division Champions Run Blue tee markers.
- c. 65-71 Age Division Champions Run White tee markers.
- d. 72 & Older Age Division Champions Run Yellow tee markers.
- **10. Play-Off:** A tie for first place will be decided by a hole-by-hole play-off beginning on Hole #17 immediately following play, unless otherwise notified by the Committee.
- 11. Pace of Play Review Committee: Craig Ames, Sam Oehm and Ben Vigil.
- 12. Final Decisions on Disputed Points will be made by Craig Ames, Sam Oehm and Ben Vigil.
