NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for NGA Championships)

1. Abnormal Course Conditions includes:

- a. Decorative Flower and Plant Beds. When enclosed by cart paths or adjacent to immovable obstructions as a single abnormal course condition.
- b. Turf Nursery located right of hole #18 from which play is prohibited. If interference exists, relief must be taken. Such nursery is not defined, but it constitutes all the area cut at approximately putting green height or less.

2. Immovable Obstructions:

- a. Birdhouses and their posts are immovable obstructions.
- b. Staked Trees (including wire and mulched tree wells associated with staked trees) are deemed to be immovable obstructions.
- c. Immovable obstructions adjacent to each other are to be treated as a single obstruction.

3. Loose Impediments:

- a. Wood chips, pine straw and mulch are loose impediments.

4. Movable Obstructions: include, but are not limited to:

- a. Staking and roping; trash cans; benches; and beverage coolers.

5. Out of Bounds:

- a. Defined by the perimeter fence posts, white dots and white lines in addition to white stakes.
- b. Defined by the pool fence between white stakes near the clubhouse.

6. Penalty Areas:

- a. The yellow penalty area on hole #15 plays as a red penalty area during play of any other hole.
- b. Dropping Zones: If a ball is in the following penalty areas, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke: 1) Take relief under Rule 17.1; or 2) As an extra option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone marked "DZ" in the location below. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.
 - i. Hole #1 Yellow Penalty Area - Drop Zone located near the yellow penalty area.
 - ii. Hole #5 Yellow or Red Penalty Area - Drop Zone located on the forward teeing area.
 - iii. Hole #6 Yellow or Red Penalty Area - Drop Zone located on the forward teeing area.
 - iv. Hole #7 Yellow or Red Penalty Area - Drop Zone located on the white teeing area.
 - v. Hole #10 Yellow Penalty Area - Drop Zone located near the yellow penalty area.
 - vi. Hole #13 Yellow Penalty Area - Drop Zone located in the fairway.

6. Temporary Immovable Obstructions: Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect. TIOs include but are not limited to: tents, fan near #11 green.

- a. Special Relief Procedure - **Either Side Relief:**
 - i) If a player is allowed relief under the TIO Local Rule, the player may take relief without penalty on either side of the TIO.

8. Deciding Ties: In the event of a tie for first place, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off following completion of the final round. The play-off rotation will be holes #1-2-3-18, unless otherwise notified by the Committee.

9. Scoring Area: A score card is returned when it has been given to the scoring official and the player has left the immediate scoring tent area.

10. Teeing Area:

- a. White NGA tee-markers define the teeing area for the girls.
- b. Red NGA tee-markers define the teeing area for the boys.

11. Transportation: During the round, a player or caddie must not ride on any form of motorized transportation except as authorized or later approved by the Committee. A player who will play, or has played, under penalty of stroke and distance is always authorized to ride on motorized transportation.

12. Pace of Play Review Committee: Justin Ahrens, Craig Ames and Ben Vigil.

13. Final Decisions on Disputed Points will be made by Justin Ahrens, Craig Ames and Ben Vigil.
