**FORMAT:** Stroke play competition conducted over 18-holes.

**QUALIFYING PLACES:** 25 entrants competing for one qualifying place and two alternate positions.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: A practice round is available at a time convenient to Oak Hills Country Club within a time

period two weeks prior to the qualifier. The rate is \$45 (includes cart). If desired, those

entered may contact the golf shop at (402) 895-4383 to make arrangements.

**CADDIES:** A player may provide his own caddie. If he wishes to have the host club furnish a caddie.

he should ask the Official in Charge because sufficient caddies may not be available.

Pull/push carts are permitted.

**REGISTRATION:** On the qualifying day, players are requested to check in upon arrival at the registration

table located near the golf shop. Registration will open at 6:30 a.m. and will be available

until all players have registered.

**PRACTICE AREAS:** Practice areas will open at 6:30 a.m. on the qualifying day. Range balls will be available

on the practice range.

**LOCKER ROOM:** Use of the locker room is permitted but individual lockers are not available.

**SPECTATORS:** Spectators are permitted and encouraged. Per USGA guidelines, the use of spectator

carts is prohibited.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE: The Pub will be available for beverage service beginning at 6:30 a.m. and food service

at 11 a.m. Coolers will be located on the golf-course with bottled water and snacks for

players and caddies.

**PLAY-OFF:** In the event of a tie for the qualifying place or two alternate positions, there will be a

hole-by-hole playoff to determine place winners immediately following the qualifying

round.

**LOWEST SCORE:** A silver medal will be awarded to the lowest scorer. If a tie, duplicate medals will be

awarded.

**ELECTRONIC SCORING:** To assist with real-time scoring we ask that one individual (player/caddie) in each group

enter player's scores after each hole. Link here to access information on downloading

the Golf Genius App for score entry.

**DRESS CODE**: Players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal

grooming. Shorts are permitted.

**FOOTWEAR:** A player must not wear shoes with traditional spikes or spikes of any design that are

entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal will come in contact with the course.

DRIVERS/GOLF BALLS: The Local Rule for Conforming Driver Heads is in effect (Model Local Rule G-1). The

Local Rule requiring that all golf balls used be on the List of Conforming Golf Balls is in effect, (Model Local Rule G-3). Please check the USGA web site for a list of approved

golf balls and drivers. The "One Ball Rule" is in effect (Model Local Rule G-4).

**GROOVE STANDARDS:** It is a requirement that a player's clubs conform to the groove and punch mark

specifications in the Equipment Rules. See Model Local Rule G-2. An Equipment

Database is found on the USGA web site.

**RANGEFINDERS:** The use of electronic distance measuring devices, to measure distance only, is allowed

(subject to certain requirements).

**CARTS:** While the player and the player's caddie may use a golf cart, there is a "one-seat" policy

in effect meaning the player and the player's caddie cannot ride in a golf cart at the same time. If two players in a group request a golf cart, only one cart will be distributed to that group. If three players request a golf cart, two carts will be distributed. Link here

**LOCAL RULES:** A pair of rules documents pertinent to this qualifier are available for review prior to this

PACE OF PLAY: Participants must play without undue delay and in accordance with pace of play
