# NEBRASKA GOLF ASSOCIATION POINT EVALUATION SYSTEM

To be used in determining exemptions, strength of field and selection of the Nebraska Amateur Golfer of the Year, Nebraska Cup Team, and Nebraska Director's Cup Team.

#### Part One – Written Portion

The purpose of the Nebraska Golf Association's (NebGolf) point evaluation system is to establish objective criteria by which the NebGolf Tournament Committee can judge the performance of golfers who participate in state and/or national tournaments concluding prior to November 1. Events concluding November 1 or later, will be rolled over into the following year.

### **Nebraska Golf Association Championships**

The number of points allocated to Nebraska Golf Association Championships are fixed. In extreme cases, the NebGolf Tournament Committee may increase or decrease the number of points allocated to these championships based upon strength of field.

### **USGA Championship Qualifiers**

The number of points allocated to USGA Championship Qualifiers are fixed. In extreme cases, the NebGolf Tournament Committee may increase or decrease the number of points allocated to these qualifiers based upon strength of field.

# Non-NebGolf Championship Point Events (Non-NebGolf Point Event)

The number of points allocated to a *Non-NebGolf Point Event* will be based upon a guaranteed minimum Tiered point structure with potential increase in Tier status based on the event's strength of field. Based on **NebGolf PLAYER RANKINGS**, eligible *Non-NebGolf Point Events* may be assigned points on one of four tier levels.

To qualify for Tier One, a *Non-NebGolf/USGA Point Event* must meet 2 of the following 3 **NebGolf PLAYER RANKINGS** criteria: 1) include 4 of the top 10; 2) include 10 of the top 25; or 3) include 13 of the top 50.

To qualify for Tier Two, a *Non-NebGolf/USGA Point Event* must meet 2 of the following 3 **NebGolf PLAYER RANKINGS** criteria: 1) include 3 of the top 10; 2) include 7 of the top 25; or 3) include 10 of the top 50.

To qualify for Tier Three, a *Non-NebGolf/USGA Point Event* must meet 2 of the following 3 **NebGolf PLAYER RANKINGS** criteria: 1) include 2 of the top 10; 2) include 5 of the top 25; or 3) include 8 of the top 50

All other events approved by the NebGolf Tournament Committee not meeting Tier 1-3 criteria, will be assigned as a Tier Four event.

To be designated as a *Non-NebGolf Point Event*, tournaments must be scheduled for at least 36-holes of competition at a NebGolf member club or an approved non-NebGolf member club. These events may not be restricted to competitors based on geographical residence and shall otherwise be approved by NebGolf. In order to be considered for point event status as a *Non-NebGolf Point Event*, tournaments shall submit to NebGolf in writing their desire for designation as such by April 1. All qualified events to be considered for *Non-NebGolf Point Event* status will be listed on the NebGolf web site's Point Tournament Schedule section as *Non-NebGolf Point Events*.

**NebGolf PLAYER RANKINGS** will be published on the NebGolf web site January 1. The rankings are based upon a player's performance in the most recent 24-month period with the last 12 months multiplied by 1.5.

#### **National Events**

The number of points allocated to these selected events are fixed. In extreme cases, the NebGolf Tournament Committee may increase or decrease the number of points allocated to these events based upon strength of field. If a player competes in a national event not listed on Page 5, the player may submit a written request (send to <a href="mailto:jahrens@nebgolf.org">jahrens@nebgolf.org</a>) for the NebGolf Tournament Committee to review the event and potentially award points in an equitable manner.

### **Tournament Participation Limit**

In order to prevent unfair advantages of one player over others, simply by playing in more tournaments, each player will only be allocated points based on the player's best six tournament finishes.

### Nebraska Cup Team

The Nebraska Cup Team is comprised of 12 players. Four players are determined by the previous year's final NebGolf Senior Point Standings, the remaining eight players are determined by the previous year's final NebGolf Point Standings. Of these eight, those golfers ranked in the top six will qualify for the team (excluding any golfers selected for the senior portion). The Nebraska Golf Association Board of Directors has granted the NebGolf Tournament Committee the right to select the remainder of the team, including replacements for qualifiers.

### **Nebraska Director's Cup Team**

The selection of the biennial six-man Nebraska Director's Cup team will be based upon the final Director's Cup Team Standings every odd numbered year. The Director's Cup Team Standings are determined by combining a player's previous year's point total with points awarded through July 31 of the current odd numbered year multiplied by 1.5. Those golfers ranked in the top four of the Director's Cup Standings will qualify for the team\*. The Nebraska Golf Association Board of Directors has granted the NebGolf Tournament Committee the right to select the remainder of the team, including replacements for qualifiers.

The NebGolf Tournament Committee will use the above point evaluation system as a guide and not as an absolute measure of a player's performance or eligibility for one or more of the Nebraska Golf Association's teams or awards. Other criteria to be used include but are not limited to: a player's GHIN or approved Handicap Index, compliance with the Rules of Golf and Rules of Amateur Status, the USGA's policy on gambling, and a player's integrity and conduct both on and off the golf course.

- \* An amateur golfer forfeiting his amateur status remains in the applicable point standings for player of the year consideration but is excluded when determining qualifiers for the Nebraska Cup Team and the Nebraska Director's Cup Team.
- \*\* For the purposes of cup team selection and postseason awards, the player in consideration must have played in at least one NebGolf Championship.
