NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for NebGolf Championships)

1. Ground Under Repair and Other Abnormal Course Conditions:

- a. Include but are not limited to: Decorative flower beds.

2. Immovable Obstructions:

- a. Include but are not limited to: All artificially surfaced roads and paths, including any adjacent curbing.
- b. Immovable obstructions adjacent to, within or abutting each other, such as artificially surfaced paths (including decorative areas enclosed by these paths), curbing, walls, steps and drains, are considered a single obstruction.
- c. Staked trees are immovable obstructions. Relief available under Rule 16.1b.

3. Movable Obstructions: Include but are not limited to:

- i) Staking and roping; trash cans; benches; and beverage coolers.

4. Penalty Areas:

- a. Dropping Zones - If a ball is in the following penalty areas, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:
 - i) proceed under Rule 17.1; or
 - ii) as an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone (marked "DZ") in the location below. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3
 - Hole #8 Yellow Penalty Area - DZ located on a forward tee.
 - Hole #14 Yellow Penalty Area - DZ located on a forward tee.
 - Hole #15 Red Penalty Area - DZ located on a forward tee.
 - Hole #16 Yellow Penalty Area - DZ located right of the green.
- b. Hole #15 - The part of the red penalty area immediately adjacent to the cart path along the right is defined by the penalty area edge of the cart path between the red stakes.

5. Out of Bounds:

- a. Defined by the nearest inside edge of white stakes and perimeter fences.
- b. Hole #1 - Out of bounds is defined by the course-side edge of the sidewalk along the left.
- c. Hole #3 - Out of Bounds is defined by the course-side edge of the rock wall in addition to white stakes and perimeter fence.
- d. Hole #5 - Out of bounds is defined by the course-side edge of the chain link fence left of the teeing area, the course-side edge of the sidewalk along the left and the course-side edge of the road behind the green.
- e. Hole #7 - Out of bounds is defined by the course-side edge of the road left of the teeing area.
- f. Hole #8 - Out of bounds is defined by the course-side edge of the road and white paint dots along the right and the course-side edge of the road behind the green.
- g. Hole #9 - Out of bounds is defined by the course-side edge of the sidewalk along the left and the course-side edge of the sidewalk behind the green.
- h. Hole #10 - Out of bounds is defined by the course-side edge of the road behind the green.
- i. Hole #12 - Out of bounds is defined by the course-side edge of the road right of and behind the green.
- j. Hole #16 - Out of bounds is defined by the course-side edge of the road along the right.
- k. Hole #17 - Out of bounds is defined by the course-side edge of the road left of the green.

6. Teeing Area: NebGolf Markers define the teeing area for the Championship; 50-57 and 58-64 Division; TPC Markers define the teeing for the 65-71 and 72 & Over Divisions.

7. Scoring Area: A player's scorecard is returned when it has been given to the scoring official and the player has left the scoring area defined by the lower patio area.

8. Play-Off: A tie for first place will be decided by a hole-by-hole play-off beginning on Hole #18 immediately following play. The play-off rotation will be #18, #10, #17, #18 repeated, unless otherwise notified by the Committee.

9. Pace of Play Review Committee: Justin Ahrens, Craig Ames and Ben Vigil.

10. Final Decisions on Disputed Points will be made by Justin Ahrens, Craig Ames and Ben Vigil.
