PAIRINGS: Pairings will be posted on the NGA's Qualifying web page (referenced below) and e-

mailed to players on Tuesday, August 1. Starting Times will range from 7:30 a.m.-9:30

a.m. off both 1 and 10 tees. Link here to access the player roster.

SCHEDULE: 6:30 a.m. Registration begins and practice areas open

7:30 a.m. Trap Room available for beverage service 7:30 a.m. Round One starting times (1st and 10th tees)

11 a.m. Trap Room available for food service

Noon Pool snack bar available for food and beverage service

Following Golf Play-off if necessary

FORMAT: Stroke play competition conducted over 18-holes.

QUALIFYING PLACES: 78 players will be competing for three (3) qualifying and two (2) alternate places. A tie for

the last qualifier's place, or an alternate's place will be decided immediately by a hole-by-

hole play-off.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Practice rounds can be arranged for a date July 1 or later by contacting Riverside GC

golf shop at (308) 382- 2648. Note: Reservations can only be arranged no sooner than one week in advance. Practice round rate is \$44+tax (walking) or \$64+tax (w/ cart).

PUSH CARTS: Push carts are **permitted** at Riverside Golf Club.

CADDIES: A player may provide his own caddie. If he wishes to have the host club furnish a caddie,

he should ask the Official in Charge because sufficient caddies may not be available.

REGISTRATION: On the qualifying day, players are requested to check in upon arrival at the registration

table located on the practice range. Registration will open at 6:30 a.m. and be available

through the final starting time.

PRACTICE AREAS: Practice areas will open at 6:30 a.m. on the qualifying day. Range balls will be available

on the practice range.

LOCKER ROOM: Participants may use the locker room but individual lockers are not available.

SPECTATORS: Spectators are permitted and encouraged. Per USGA guidelines, the use of spectator

carts is prohibited.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE: The Trap Room will be open for beverage service at 7:30 a.m. and food service at 11

a.m. The pool snack bar will be available for food and beverage service at noon. Coolers

will be located on the golf-course with bottled water for players and caddies.

PLAY-OFF: In the event of a tie for the last qualifying place or two alternate positions, there will be a

hole-by-hole playoff to determine place winners immediately following the qualifier.

LOWEST SCORE: A silver medal will be awarded to the lowest scorer. If a tie, duplicate medals will be

awarded.

ELECTRONIC SCORING: To assist with real-time scoring we ask that one individual (player/caddie) in each group

enter player's scores after each hole. Link here to access information on downloading

the Golf Genius App for score entry.

DRESS CODE: Players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal

grooming.

FOOTWEAR: A player must not wear shoes with traditional spikes or spikes of any design that are

entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal will come in contact with the course.

DRIVERS/GOLF BALLS: The Local Rule for Conforming Driver Heads is in effect (Model Local Rule G-1). The

Local Rule requiring that all golf balls used be on the List of Conforming Golf Balls is in effect, (Model Local Rule G-3). Please check the USGA web site for a list of approved

golf balls and drivers. The "One Ball Rule" is not in effect.

GROOVE STANDARDS: It is a requirement that a player's clubs conform to the groove and punch mark

specifications in the Equipment Rules. See Model Local Rule G-2. An Equipment

Database is found on the USGA web site.

RANGEFINDERS: The use of electronic distance measuring devices, to measure distance only, is allowed

(subject to certain requirements).

CARTS: Players and caddies must not ride on any form of transportation during qualifying

rounds unless authorized by the on-site Rules Committee.

LOCAL RULES: A pair of rules documents pertinent to this qualifier are available for review prior to this

competition. Link here to access the USGA's Local Rules & Terms of the Competition

and the Notice to Players (specific to qualifying Riverside Golf Club).

PACE OF PLAY: Participants must play without undue delay and in accordance with pace of play

guidelines established by the NGA attached here.

EVACUATION PLAN: In the event of a discontinuance of play during the qualifier, players must adhere to the

evacuation plan attached here.
