NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for NebGolf Championships)

- 1. Advice: Model Local Rule H-2 is in effect. Each team may name two advice givers whom players on the team may ask for advice and receive advice from during the round, so long as:
- a. Each advice giver is designated by the institution's athletic department to perform coaching duties; and
- b. They must be identified to the NGA before any player on the team begins their round; and
- c. They must wear the identification band provided by NebGolf.
- 2. Transportation: Model Local Rule G-6 is in effect. During the round, a player must not ride on any form of motorized transportation except as authorized or later approved by the Committee. A player who will play, or has played, under penalty of stroke and distance is always authorized to ride on motorized transportation.
- 3. Caddies: Model Local Rule H-1.1 is in effect. Rule 10.3a is modified in this way:
- a. A player must not have a caddie during the round.

4. Sandy Areas

a. All sandy areas are part of the General Area.

5. Immovable Obstructions:

- a. Include but are not limited to:
 - i.) All cart paths either surfaced with rock, sandy paths, dirt or grass covered.
- b. Clubhouse, including adjacent and surrounding artificially surfaced paths, curbing, walls, steps, patios, fences and/or decorative plantings, are considered a single obstruction.
- c. Immovable Obstructions Close to the Putting Green: Model Local Rule F-5 is in effect.
 - i.) Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under Rule 16.1.
 - ii.) The player also has these extra options to take relief when such immovable obstructions are close to the putting green and on the line of play:
 - Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is:
 - On the line of play, and is:
 - » Within two club-lengths of the putting green, and
 - » Within two club-lengths of the ball.
 - iii.) Exception No Relief If Line of Play Clearly Unreasonable. There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.

6. Movable Obstructions:

- a. Include but are not limited to:
 - i.) Staking and roping; trash cans; benches; and beverage coolers.

7. Out of Bounds:

- a. Out of bounds is defined by perimeter fence in addition to white stakes.
- b. Hole #1: Out of Bounds is defined by the course-side edge of Hwy. 44 along the left side, and the course-side edge of the gravel road behind the green.
- c. Hole #4: Out of Bounds is defined by the course-side edge of Links Ridge Road when stakes or a perimeter fence is not present.
- d. Hole #6: Out of Bounds is defined by the course-side edge of Pheasant Run Road, stakes with red tops and the perimeter fence.
- e. Hole #9: Out of Bounds is defined by the course-side edge of S Road behind the green. Model Local Rule A-3 is in effect.
- f. Hole#18: Out of Bounds is defined by the course-side edge of S Road to the right, in addition to white stakes. Model Local Rule A-3 is in effect.

8. Penalty Areas:

- a. **Dropping Zones** If a ball is in the red penalty area on Hole #4, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:
 - i.) proceed under Rule 17.1; or
 - ii.) as an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone (marked "DZ") near the cart path. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.
- 9. Temporary Immovable Obstructions (TIOs): Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect. TIOs include but are not limited to: USGA/NebGolf signage and tents.
- a. Special Relief Procedure Either Side Relief:
 - i.) If a player is allowed relief under the TIO Local Rule, the player may take relief without penalty on either side of the TIO.
- 10. Play-Off: In the event of a tie for the team champion in each division, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off, scoring all five scores on each hole until a winner is determined. In the event of a tie for the individual champion in each division, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off until a winner is determined. The play-off rotation will be holes #10, #11, #12 and #18.
- 11. Scoring Area: A scorecard is deemed to be returned when the player has left the scoring area.

12. Teeing Area:

- a. Red NebGolf tee-markers define the teeing area for the men.
- b. White NebGolf tee-markers define the teeing area for the women.
