NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for NebGolf Championships)

1. Abnormal Course Conditions includes:

- a. Decorative flower beds (including all rock beds).
- b. Young trees with mulch surrounds are deemed to be an immovable obstruction.

2. Immovable Obstructions:

- a. Include but are not limited to:
 - (i) Artificially surfaced roads and paths including those surfaced with crushed rock, gravel and asphalt.
- b. Immovable obstructions adjacent to, within or abutting each other, such as artificially surfaced paths (including decorative areas enclosed by these paths), curbing, walls, steps and drains, are considered a single obstruction.
- c. Permanent restrooms and structures, including adjacent and surrounding artificially surfaced paths, patios, and decorative plantings, are considered a single obstruction.
- d. White Stakes used to define out of bounds along the right of hole #13 are deemed to be immovable obstructions during play of any other hole.

3. Movable Obstructions: include, but are not limited to:

- a. Staking and roping; trash cans; benches; and beverage coolers.

4. Out of Bounds:

- a. Defined by the nearest inside edge of perimeter fence posts and white stakes.
- b. Hole #1 - Out of bounds along the left side is defined by the course-side edge of the curbing of the public road.
- c. Hole #2 - Out of bounds along the left side is defined by the white line.
- d. White stakes along the right side of hole #13 are out of bounds during play of that hole only.

5. Penalty Area:

- a. Hole #14 - Yellow penalty area along the right is treated as a Red penalty area.

6. Temporary Immovable Obstructions: Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect. TIOs include but are not limited to: tents.

- a. Special Relief Procedure - **Either Side Relief:**
 - i) If a player is allowed relief under the TIO Local Rule, the player may take relief without penalty on either side of the TIO.

7. Play-Off: A tie for first place will be decided by a hole-by-hole play-off beginning on Hole #18 immediately following play. The play-off rotation will be #18, #15, #16, #17, #18 repeated, unless otherwise notified by the Committee.

9. Scoring Area: A scorecard is returned when it has been given to the scoring official and the player has left the scoring tent defined by blue dots.

10. Teeing Area:

- a. Red NebGolf tee-markers define the teeing area for the Championship and 50-57 divisions.
- b. White NebGolf tee-markers define the teeing area for the 58-64 and 65-71 divisions.
- c. Red Wayne CC tee-markers define the teeing area for the 72 & Over division.

12. Pace of Play Review Committee: Justin Ahrens, Craig Ames and Ben Vigil.

13. Final Decisions on Disputed Points will be made by Justin Ahrens, Craig Ames and Ben Vigil.
