NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for NebGolf Championships)

1. Immovable Obstructions:

- a. Include but are not limited to:
 - i.) Artificially surfaced roads and paths include those surfaced with crushed brick, concrete, gravel, or rock.
 - ii.) Railroad tie retaining walls within bunkers.
 - iii.) Railroad tie walkways within bunkers.
 - iv.) Straw bails and stakes in run off areas.
- b. Rubber mat extensions adjacent to cart paths or abutting each other are considered a single obstruction.
- c. Straw bails and stakes adjacent to cart paths or abutting each other are considered a single obstruction.
- d. Halfway house, including concrete patio, gravel surrounding, and railroad ties are a single obstruction.
- e. Clubhouse, including adjacent and surrounding concrete paths, patio, fence and gravel lot, are a single obstruction.
- f. Immovable Obstructions Close to the Putting Green: Model Local Rule F-5 is in effect. Relief is only available when both the obstruction and the ball lie in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less.
 - i.) Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under Rule 16.1.
 - ii.) The player also has these extra options to take relief when such immovable obstructions are close to the putting green and on the line of play:
 - a) Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b only if the obstruction and the ball are in the general area cut to fairway height or less, and is:
 - On the line of play, and is:
 - » Within two club-lengths of the putting green, and
 - » Within two club-lengths of the ball.
 - iii.) Exception - No Relief if Line of Play Clearly Unreasonable. There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.

2. Integral Objects:

- a. Sand and dirt paths or roads (maintenance vehicle cut throughs) are integral objects and free relief is not available.
- b. Artificial turf bunker faces are integral objects and free relief is not available.

3. Movable Obstructions:

- a. Include but are not limited to:
 - i.) Staking and roping; trash cans; benches; and beverage coolers.

4. Native Grass:

- a. Areas of native grass are part of the General Area.

5. Out of Bounds:

- a. Out of bounds is defined by perimeter fence in addition to white stakes and lines.
- b. Hole #14 - Out of bounds is defined by the course side edge of Ireton Avenue along the right side.

6. Paint Dots and Lines Not Used for Course Marking:

- a. Blue paint dots are used to separate the practice green and 18th green. Free relief is not available.

7. Hole #18 Putting Green; Practice:

- a. Practice is permitted before the round on or near the left side of the putting green (i.e., the #1 tee side of the blue stakes). The practice portion of the putting green is not considered a wrong green.

8. Temporary Immovable Obstructions (TIOs):

Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect. TIOs include but are not limited to: championship tents and construction equipment.

a. Special Relief Procedure - **Either Side Relief:**

- i.) If a player is allowed relief under the TIO Local Rule, the player may take relief without penalty on either side of the TIO.

9. Play-Off to Determine Match Play:

In the event of a tie for the last spot(s) after 18-holes of stroke play, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off following completion of stroke play qualifying. The play-off will begin on hole #1.

10. Match Tied after 18-Holes:

The match is extended one hole at a time in the same order as in the round until a winner is determined, unless otherwise stated by the Committee.

11. Scoring Area:

A scorecard is deemed to be returned when the player has left the scoring area defined by blue dots.

12. Teeing Area:

- a. Red NebGolf tee-markers define the teeing area for the Championship Division.
- b. White NebGolf tee-markers define the teeing area for the Tournament Division.
