QUALIFYING PLACES:	The number of qualifying places for our site will be announced by the USGA (and posted to the qualifying web site noted just below) on Friday, May 16. The same information will be shared with players via e-mail with pairings on Thursday, May 22. A tie for the last qualifier's place, or an alternate's place will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole play-off. Link here to access the field.

PRACTICE ROUNDS:	Practice rounds are available at a time convenient to Shadow Ridge Country Club at a rate of \$50 (includes cart and use of the practice range). If desired, those entered may contact Joe Finnegan in the golf shop at (402) 333-0500 to make arrangements. <i>Note: Times on weekends (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) and Memorial Day are not</i> available until after 2 p.m. Because Memorial Day holiday is the day prior to the qualifier, any effort to play a practice round prior to that day would be appreciated. The club asks that participants limit use of the practice facility to pre-round only up to one hour prior to your starting time.

- **SPECTATORS:** Spectators are permitted and encouraged. Per USGA guidelines, <u>the use of spectator</u> <u>carts is prohibited</u>.
- **FOOD AND BEVERAGE:** On the qualifying day, beverage service will be available in the lower level of the clubhouse beginning at 6:30 a.m. Coolers will be located on the golf-course with bottled water for players and caddies and course bars will be open for beverage purchases. The outdoor patio will be available to participants and guests for food service beginning at 11 a.m.
- **PLAY-OFF:** In the event of a tie for the last qualifying place or any alternate positions, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff to determine place winners immediately following qualifying.
- LOWEST SCORE: A silver medal will be awarded to the lowest scorer. If a tie, duplicate medals will be awarded. A silver medal will also be awarded to the lowest amateur scorer (if not the lowest scorer). If a tie, duplicate medals will also be awarded
- ELECTRONIC SCORING: To assist with real-time scoring we ask that one individual (player/caddie) in each group enter player's scores after each hole. Link here to access information on downloading the Golf Genius App for score entry.
- **DRESS CODE**: Players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Shorts are permitted.
- **FOOTWEAR:** A player must not wear shoes with traditional spikes or spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal will come in contact with the course.
- **DRIVERS/GOLF BALLS:** The Local Rule for Conforming Driver Heads is in effect (Model Local Rule G-1). The Local Rule requiring that all golf balls used be on the List of Conforming Golf Balls is in effect, (Model Local Rule G-3). <u>Please check the USGA web site for a list of approved golf balls and drivers</u>. The "One Ball Rule" is <u>not</u> in effect (Model Local Rule G-4).
- **GROOVE STANDARDS:** It is a requirement that a player's clubs conform to the groove and punch mark specifications in the Equipment Rules (Model Local Rule G-2). "The exception for Ping Eye2 Irons manufactured before 31 March 1990" is not in effect. <u>An Equipment Database is found on the USGA web site</u>.
- **RANGEFINDERS:** During both Local and Final Qualifying rounds, the use of electronic distance measuring devices, to measure distance only, is allowed (<u>subject to certain requirements</u>).
- **CARTS:** Players and caddies must not ride on any form of transportation during the qualifying round unless authorized by the on-site Rules Committee.
- LOCAL RULES: A pair of rules documents pertinent to this qualifier are available for review prior to this competition. Link here to access the <u>USGA's Local Rules & Terms of the Competition</u> and the <u>Notice to Players (specific to qualifying at Shadow Ridge Country Club)</u>.
- PACE OF PLAY: Participants must play without undue delay and in accordance with <u>pace of play</u> <u>guidelines established by NebGolf attached here</u>.
- **EVACUATION PLAN:** In the event of a discontinuance of play during the qualifier, players must adhere to the <u>evacuation plan attached here</u>.
