NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for NebGolf Championships)

- 1. Abnormal Course Conditions including Ground Under Repair**
 - a. Decorative Flower and Plant Beds.
 - i) Are ground under repair even though not defined by white lines.
 - ii) When enclosed by cart paths or adjacent to immovable obstructions are treated as a single abnormal course condition.
- 2. Immovable Obstructions**
 - a. Include but are not limited to:
 - i) Artificially surfaced roads and paths include those surfaced with crushed brick, concrete, gravel, or rock.
 - b. Immovable obstructions adjacent to, within or abutting each other, such as artificially surfaced paths (including decorative areas enclosed by these paths), curbing, walls, steps and drains, are considered a single obstruction.
 - c. Permanent restrooms, including adjacent and surrounding artificially surfaced paths, curbing, walls, steps, patios, fences and/or decorative plantings, are considered a single obstruction.
- 3. Integral Objects**
 - a. Mulch path located along the right side of Hole #15 is an integral object. No relief without penalty.
- 4. Movable Obstructions**
 - a. Include but are not limited to:
 - i) Staking and roping; trash cans; benches; beverage coolers and their stands.
- 5. Out of Bounds**
 - a. Out of bounds is defined by perimeter fence in addition to white stakes and white lines.
 - b. The parking lot, paved entrance road and areas within these boundaries are out of bounds defined by the course side edge of the pavement.
- 6. Penalty Areas**
 - a. Hole #11 – The part of the ditch marked as a yellow penalty area is treated as a Red penalty area during the play of Hole #11.
 - b. Dropping Zones - If a ball is in the following penalty areas, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:
 - i) proceed under Rule 17.1; or
 - ii) as an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone (marked "DZ") in the location below. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.
 - Hole #6 Red Penalty Area behind the green – Closest of the two DZ's located behind the green.
- 7. Temporary Immovable Obstructions (TIOs):** Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect. TIOs include but are not limited to championship sponsor signs and tents.
 - a. Special Relief Procedure - **Either Side Relief:**
 - i) If a player is allowed relief under the TIO Local Rule, the player may take relief without penalty on either side of the TIO.
- 8. Unplayable Ball**
 - a. Dropping Zone: If a ball is unplayable in the area between the green painted posts right of the putting green on Hole #14, the player may proceed (i) under Rule 19.2 or (ii) as an extra option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke in the closest of the two DZ's located behind the green and right of the cart path. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.
- 9. Play-Off to Determine Match Play Field:** In the event of a tie for the last spot(s) after 18-holes of stroke play, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off following completion of the round on Monday. The play-off rotation will be holes #10-16-17-18 repeated, as necessary.
- 10. Match Tied after 18-Holes:** The match is extended one hole at a time in the same order as in the round until a winner is determined, unless otherwise stated by the Committee.
- 11. Stroke Play Scoring Area:** A scorecard is deemed to be returned when the player has left the scoring tent.
- 12. Teeing Area:**
 - a. White NebGolf tee-markers define the teeing area for the girls.
 - b. Red NebGolf tee-markers define the teeing area for the boys.
- 13. Transportation:** During the round, a player or caddie must not ride on any form of motorized transportation except as authorized or later approved by the Committee. A player who will play, or has played, under penalty of stroke and distance is always authorized to ride on motorized transportation.
- 14. Pace of Play Review Committee:** Justin Ahrens, Ben Vigil, and Juliana Botero.
- 15. Final Decisions on Disputed Points** will be made by Justin Ahrens, Ben Vigil, and Juliana Botero.
