NEBRASKA WOMEN'S POINT EVALUATION SYSTEM

NEBRASKA GOLF ASSOCIATION

To be used in determining exemptions, strength of field, selection of the Nebraska Women's Amateur Golfer of the Year and any necessary Select Teams.

Part One - Written Portion

The purpose of the Nebraska Women's Point Evaluation System is to establish objective criteria by which the Nebraska Golf Association can judge the performance of golfers who participate in state and/or national tournaments beginning after March 31 and concluding prior to November 1.

Nebraska Women's Amateur Golf Championships

The number of points allocated to Nebraska Women's Amateur Golf Championships are fixed. In extreme cases, NGA may increase or decrease the number of points allocated to these championships based upon strength of field.

USGA Championship Qualifiers

The number of points allocated to USGA Championship Qualifiers are fixed. In extreme cases, NGA may increase or decrease the number of points allocated to these qualifiers based upon strength of field.

Member Club Events

In order to be considered for point event status as a *Member Club Event*, tournaments shall submit to NGA in writing their desire for designation as such including a list of participants. These tournaments must be scheduled for at least 36-holes of competition at a NGA member club or an approved non-NGA member club. Based on an approved event's strength of field, it will be assigned to one of three point levels.

National Events

The number of points allocated to national events are fixed. In extreme cases, NGA may increase or decrease the number of points allocated to these events based upon strength of field. If a player competes in a national event not listed, the player may submit a written request (send to jahrens@nebgolf.org) for NGA to review and potentially award points in an equitable manner.

Tournament Participation Limit

In order to prevent unfair advantages of one player over others, simply by playing in more tournaments, each player will only be allocated points based on the player's best five tournament finishes. At least one of the player's five point finishes must be from a Nebraska Women's Amateur Golf Championship.

NGA will use the above point evaluation system as a guide and not as an absolute measure of a player's performance or eligibility for award or team selection. Other criteria to be used include but are not limited to: a player's Handicap Index, compliance with the Rules of Golf and Rules of Amateur Status, the USGA's policy on gambling, and a player's integrity and conduct both on and off the golf course.

* An amateur golfer forfeiting her amateur status remains in the applicable point standings for player of the year consideration but is excluded when determining select teams.
