NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for NebGolf Championships)

- 1. Abnormal Course Conditions include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Decorative flower beds (including all rock beds).
 - b. Turf plugs on putting greens are ground under repair. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1d.
 - c. Hole #13 Putting Green The ground under repair on Hole #13 putting green is defined by white dots.
- 2. Advice: Model Local Rule H-2 is in effect. Each team may name two advice givers whom players on the team may ask for advice and receive advice from during the round, so long as:
 - a. Each advice giver is designated by the institution's athletic department to perform coaching duties; and
 - b. They must be identified to NebGolf before any player on the team begins their round.
- 3. Caddies: Model Local Rule H-1.1 is in effect. Rule 10.3a is modified in this way:
 - a. A player must not have a caddie during the round.
- 4. Immovable Obstructions, include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Artificially surfaced roads and paths including those surfaced with crushed rock, gravel and asphalt.
 - b. Rubber mats adjacent to cart paths.
 - c. Railroad tracks and rock beds bordering the tracks.
 - d. Immovable obstructions adjacent to, within or abutting each other, such as artificially surfaced paths (including decorative areas enclosed by these paths), curbing, walls, steps and drains, are considered a single obstruction.
 - e. Permanent restrooms and structures, including adjacent and surrounding artificially surfaced paths, patios, and decorative plantings, are considered a single obstruction.
 - f. Young trees identified by an orange stake are deemed to be an immovable obstruction.
- 5. Movable Obstructions, include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Staking and roping; trash cans; benches; and beverage coolers.
 - b. White Stakes used to define out of bounds along the right of hole #13 are deemed to be movable obstructions during play of any other hole.

6. Penalty Areas:

- a. Dropping Zones If a ball is in the following penalty areas, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:
 - i) proceed under Rule 17.1; or
 - ii) as an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone (marked "DZ") in the location below. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3
 - Hole #9 Yellow Penalty Area DZ located in the fairway.
 - Hole #10 Red Penalty Area DZ located behind the green.
 - Hole #11 Red Penalty Area DZs located behind the green. The player may drop on the closer of the two DZs.
- b. Faded Lines Faded lines near or in red penalty areas or yellow penalty areas have no status when more recently painted red or yellow lines are present.

7. Out of Bounds:

- a. Defined by the nearest inside edge of perimeter fence posts and white stakes.
- b. White stakes along the right side of hole #13 are out of bounds during play of that hole only.
- 8. Power Lines: Model Local Rule E-11 is in effect.
 - a. If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line during the play of hole #5, the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made.
- 9. **Scoring Area:** A score card is returned when it has been given to the scoring official and the player has left the scoring area defined by a 30' diameter from the scoring table.
- 10. Teeing Area:
 - a. Men Red NebGolf tee markers.
 - b. Women White NebGolf tee markers.
- 11. Play-Off: In the event of a tie for the team champion in each division, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off, scoring all five scores on each hole until a winner is determined. In the event of a tie for the individual champion in each division, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off until a winner is determined. The play-off rotation will be holes #1, #17 and #18 repeated, unless otherwise determined by the Committee.
- 12. Transportation: Model Local Rule G-6 is in effect. During the round, a player must not ride on any form of motorized transportation except as authorized or later approved by the Committee. A player who will play, or has played, under penalty of stroke and distance is always authorized to ride on motorized transportation.
- 13. Final Decisions on Disputed Points will be made by Justin Ahrens, Craig Ames, Juliana Botero and Ben Vigil.
