PRACTICE ROUNDS

Each player is entitled to one practice round, free-of-charge (walking), the week prior to the championship. Tee times are based on availability (preferably on weekdays), so please call the Oakland GC golf shop at (402) 658-5339 and reserve your time as soon as possible.

REGISTRATION

Registration will be located outside the golf shop, beginning at 7 a.m. Monday. Players **ARE REQUIRED** to check in prior to starting their first round.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Practice areas will open at 7 a.m. on Tuesday and Wednesday, and 6:30 a.m. on Thursday and Friday. Range balls will be available outside the golf shop. The practice range at Fremont GC is located North of the main clubhouse, past #7 & #11 Tees. In addition, Oakland GC features a short game area by the golf shop, and a practice green near the first tee.

STARTING TIMES

Starting times for Rounds One and Two will be posted following the deadline. See the pairings tab on the championship web site for your assigned starting tee and time. It is your responsibility to be present at your assigned starting tee and ready to play at the assigned time.

CADDIES

A player may provide his/her own caddie. Caddies must wear bibs provided by NebGolf, which will be available on the starting tees. **Exception: A player may not use a parent or guardian as a caddie.**

SCORING

Scorecards will be used during the stroke play qualifier. One player (or caddie) in each group will be required to enter hole-by-hole scores digitally via an electronic device (cell phone) through the Golf Genius app. Players are asked to download the Golf Genius app prior to the start of their first round. Complete instructions on how to download the GG app, login, and keep score will be at the starter's table. Upon completion of the qualifying round players will enter the designated scoring area to review, verify and sign their scorecards.

FORMAT

Stroke Play – Girls—54 Holes; Boys—54 Holes.

MONDAY A.M. & P.M., JUNE 8, First Round, 18-holes. (Boys & Girls)

TUESDAY A.M. & P.M., JUNE 9, Second Round, 18-holes. (Boys & Girls)

The low 15 scores and ties will advance to play the girls' Final Round on Wednesday.

The low 36 scores and ties will advance to play the boys' Final Round on Wednesday.

WEDNESDAY A.M., JUNE 10, Final Round, 18-holes. (Boys & Girls)

Girls' Lowest Score for 54 holes will be champion. Boys' Lowest Score for 54 holes will be champion. A tie for first place will be played off hole-by-hole until a champion is determined.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

Water stations will be available on-course, along with complimentary snacks/fruit on the starting tees. The Snack Shack near the pool will be open for food & beverage service each day of the championship.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

If you must withdraw, notify the NebGolf office immediately. Please call Juliana Botero at (402) 505-4653, ext. 101, or via email (jbotero@nebgorf.org). Failure to comply may render you liable to disqualification from future NebGolf Championships.

PERSONAL EFFECTS

Spectators are allowed. Carts will be allowed, based on availability, for spectators to rent.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing.

SCORE POSTING

All qualifying scores will be posted for handicap purposes. Players should not post these scores individually. Match Play scores will not be posted by NebGolf. Players should post these scores individually as competitions scores in accordance with the Rules of Handicapping under the World Handicap System.

PRIZES

WINNER: Custody of championship trophy, gold medal and a NebGolf trophy to keep.

RUNNER-UP: Silver medal and a NebGolf trophy.

TOP 10: Bronze Medal.
