

**Nebraska Golf Association  
Girls' Point Evaluation System**

*To be used in determining exemptions and selecting the NWAGA Girls' Four-State Team, NebGolf Junior All-Star Team, and the Nebraska Girls' Amateur Golfer of the Year.*

**Part One – Written Portion**

The purpose of the Nebraska Golf Association (NebGolf) girls' point evaluation system is to establish objective criteria by which the NebGolf Junior Committee can judge the performance of junior girls golfers who participate in state and/or national tournaments concluding prior **to October 1**. Events concluding October 1 or later, including the NSAA Girls' Golf Championships, will be rolled over into the following year.

**Tournament Participation Limit**

In order to prevent unfair advantages of one player over others, simply by playing in more tournaments, each player will only be allocated points based on her best six tournament finishes.

Tournaments included in the NebGolf Girls' Point Evaluation are limited to those events listed on page 2. Each is pre-assigned a point level. If a player competes in a national event not included on any of those pages, the player may submit a written request (send to [jbotero@nebgolf.org](mailto:jbotero@nebgolf.org)) for the NebGolf Junior Committee to review the event and potentially award points in an equitable manner.

**Girls' Four-State Team**

The selection of the annual 6-woman Nebraska Girls' Four-State Team will be based upon the previous year's NebGolf Girls' Point Standings with the addition of the points for that year's NSAA Girls' Golf Championships. Eligible golfers ranked in the top four will qualify for the team. The Nebraska Women's Amateur Golf Association Board of Directors has granted the NWAGA Junior Committee the right to select the remainder of the team, including replacements for qualifiers as late as two weeks prior to the Girls' Four-State Competition.

**NebGolf Junior All-Star Teams and Girls' Golfer of the Year Award**

The selection of the five girls to the annual NebGolf Junior All-Star Team and the Nebraska Girls' Golfer of the Year award will be based upon NebGolf Girls' Point Standings published October 1. The player must play in a NebGolf championship or USGA Qualifier/Championship to be eligible for these postseason awards.

NOTES: For tournaments including a cut, either for additional rounds of stroke play or to a match play bracket, only players making the cut are eligible for points. For tournaments with multiple age divisions, points are awarded only to the oldest age division, unless other divisions play the same yardage, in which case the results are combined.
