NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for NebGolf Championships)

- 1. Abnormal Course Conditions including Ground Under Repair**
 - a. Decorative Flower and Plant Beds.
 - i) Are ground under repair even though not defined by white lines.
 - ii) When enclosed by cart paths or adjacent to immovable obstructions are treated as a single abnormal course condition.
- 2. Immovable Obstructions**
 - a. Include but are not limited to:
 - i) Artificially surfaced roads and paths including those surfaced with crushed rock, gravel and asphalt.
 - ii) Rubber mats adjacent to cart paths.
 - iii) Railroad tracks and rock beds bordering the tracks.
 - iv) Young trees identified by an orange stake are deemed to be an immovable obstruction
 - v) Artificially surfaced roads and paths include those surfaced with crushed brick, concrete, gravel, or rock.
 - b. Immovable obstructions adjacent to, within or abutting each other, such as artificially surfaced paths (including decorative areas enclosed by these paths), curbing, walls, steps and drains, are considered a single obstruction.
 - c. Permanent restrooms, including adjacent and surrounding artificially surfaced paths, curbing, walls, steps, patios, fences and/or decorative plantings, are considered a single obstruction.
- 3. Movable Obstructions**
 - a. Include but are not limited to:
 - i) Staking and roping; trash cans; benches; beverage coolers and their stands.
 - ii) White Stakes used to define out of bounds along the right of hole #13 are deemed to be movable obstructions during play of any other hole
- 4. Out of Bounds**
 - a. Out of bounds is defined by perimeter fence in addition to white stakes, white lines and white dots.
 - b. White stakes along the right side of hole #13 are out of bounds during play of that hole only.
- 5. Penalty Areas**
 - a. Dropping Zones - If a ball is in the following penalty areas, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:
 - i) proceed under Rule 17.1; or
 - ii) as an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone (marked "DZ") in the location below. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.
 - Hole #9 Yellow Penalty Area - DZ located in the fairway.
 - Hole #10 Red Penalty Area - DZ located behind the green.
 - Hole #11 Red Penalty Area - DZs located behind the green. The player may drop on the closer of the two DZs.
- 6. Temporary Immovable Obstructions (TIOs):** Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect. TIOs include but are not limited to championship sponsor signs and tents.
 - a. Special Relief Procedure - **Either Side Relief:**
 - i) If a player is allowed relief under the TIO Local Rule, the player may take relief without penalty on either side of the TIO.
- 7. Play-Off to Determine Match Play Field:** In the event of a tie for the last spot(s) in match play brackets after 18-holes of stroke play, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off following completion of the round on Monday. The play-off will begin on hole #1, unless otherwise notified by the Committee.
- 8. Match Tied after 18-Holes:** The match is extended one hole at a time in the same order as in the round until a winner is determined, unless otherwise stated by the Committee.
- 9. Stroke Play Scoring Area:** A scorecard is deemed to be returned when the player has left the scoring tent.
- 10. Teeing Area:**
 - a. White NebGolf tee-markers define the teeing area for the girls.
 - b. Red NebGolf tee-markers define the teeing area for the boys.
- 11. Transportation:** During the round, a player or caddie must not ride on any form of motorized transportation except as authorized or later approved by the Committee. A player who will play, or has played, under penalty of stroke and distance is always authorized to ride on motorized transportation.
- 12. Caddies:** A player may provide his/her own caddie. A player may not use a parent or guardian as a caddie.
- 13. Pace of Play Review Committee:** Craig Ames, Justin Ahrens, Ben Vigil, and Juliana Botero.
- 14. Final Decisions on Disputed Points** will be made by Craig Ames, Justin Ahrens, Ben Vigil, and Juliana Botero.
