PRACTICE ROUNDS

Practice rounds are available at a time convenient to the club and may be arranged by contacting the York Country Club Pro Shop at (402) 362-3721. Cost of the practice round is \$50 (includes cart).

PLAYER REGISTRATION

All players must register prior to their stroke play qualifying round and check-in with NebGolf. A registration/check-in table will be located near the cart staging area.

CADDIES

Are permitted.

CARTS & PUSH CARTS

Automotive transportation (cart) is permitted. Only two (2) carts per group will be allowed. Under no circumstances will three (3) carts be allowed in a group. Players should expect to be paired up for cart use. Caddies may be asked to walk if carts are occupied by players.

Push carts are permitted.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

The practice facility will open one hour before the first start time each day of the Championship. Practice balls are complimentary and will be available on the practice range.

FORMAT

Golfers will participate in an 18-hole stroke play qualifier to determine a 32-player Championship match play bracket. Those not in the top 32 will not advance to match play and will be eliminated.

Competition will be in two stages.

A) Stroke Play – 18 holes stroke play to determine flights and seeds for match play. A tie for the last qualifier's place in the championship bracket will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole play-off.

B) Match Play – General numerical draw will be used. For purposes of determining places in the draw, ties in qualifying rounds will be decided by a blind draw, except that places of those participating in a play-off will be determined by the order on the public scoreboard summary and by performance in the play-off.

SCORING

Scorecards will be distributed during the championship. One player or caddie in each group will be required to enter hole-by-hole scores digitally. Players are asked to download the Golf Genius app prior to the start of their first round. Complete instructions on how to download the Golf Genius app, login, and keep score may be found on page 5 of this memorandum. Upon completion of the round players will enter the designated scoring area to review, verify and sign scorecards.

PRIZES

Championship Division: Qualifying Medalist – bronze medal to keep

Championship Bracket: Champion – custody of the traveling trophy, trophy and gold medal to keep; Runner-Up – trophy and silver medal to keep. Merchandise payouts to be announced.

ON-COURSE AMENITIES (WATER & SNACKS)

Bottled water will be available for players and caddies on #1 tee and #10 tee. Snacks, i.e. fruit, energy bars, etc. will be available on #1 and #10 tees.

SPECTATORS

Spectators are allowed. Spectator carts are permitted, based on availability during the championship.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

If you must withdraw, notify the NebGolf office immediately. Please call Justin Ahrens at (402) 505-4653, ext. 104 or at (402) 380-1916. Failure to comply may render you liable to disqualification from future NebGolf Championships.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

The clubhouse will be open for food and beverage service during the championship. Cash and credit card accepted.

DRESS CODE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply. Absolutely No Traditional Metal Spikes.
