NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship Entry & The Local Rules and Terms of the Competition for 2026 NebGolf Championships)

1. Championship Related Signs:

- a. Signs that are fixed in the ground or on drive stakes are TIOs. Examples of these are tee signs, sponsor signs, informational signs, and when these are readily movable, they may be moved. If there is a drive stake, it remains a TIO.

2. Abnormal Course Conditions includes but is not limited to:

- a. Decorative flower beds.
- b. Mulch tree basins.

3. Immovable Obstructions include but are not limited to:

- a. All artificially surfaced roads and paths, including any adjacent curbing.
- b. Birdhouses and their posts.
- c. Staked trees (including wire and mulched tree wells associated with staked trees).

4. Movable Obstructions include but are not limited to:

- a. Staking and roping; trash cans; benches; and beverage coolers.

5. No Play Zone: Turf nursery located right of Hole #18 is a No Play Zone. If interference exists, relief must be taken. Such nursery is not defined, but it constitutes all the area cut at approximately putting green height or less.

6. Out of Bounds:

- a. In addition to white stakes and perimeter fence posts, out of bounds is defined by white lines and dots.
- b. Defined by the pool fence between white stakes near the clubhouse.
- c. Immovable obstructions adjacent to, within or abutting each other, such as artificially surfaced paths (including decorative areas enclosed by these paths), curbing, walls, steps and drains, are considered a single obstruction.

7. Penalty Areas:

- a. The Yellow Penalty Area on Hole #15 plays as a Red Penalty Area during play of another hole.
- b. Dropping Zones - If a ball is in the following penalty areas, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke: proceed under Rule 17.1; or as an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone (marked "DZ") in the location below. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3
 - i. Hole #1 Yellow Penalty Area – DZ located near the yellow penalty area.
 - ii. Hole #5 Yellow or Red Penalty Area – DZ located on the forward tee.
 - iii. Hole #6 Red Penalty Area – DZ located on the forward tee.
 - iv. Hole #6 Red Penalty Area Behind the Green – DZ located behind the green.
 - v. Hole #7 Red Penalty Area – DZ located on the white tee.

8. Temporary Immovable Obstructions: Relief on Either Side. Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect and includes starting and scoring tents. If a player has either physical interference or line of sight interference from any TIO and is entitled to relief, as an additional option, they may take relief on the other side of the TIO along the arc without penalty. When taking relief on the other side of the TIO, the player may only take relief under the TIO Local Rule, not Rule 16.1.

9. Teeing Area: The White NebGolf tee-markers define the teeing area.

10. Scoring Area: A scorecard is returned when the player has left the scoring area defined by the immediate area around the scoring tent.

11. Deciding Ties: In the event of a tie for the championship, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff to determine the winner. The play-off rotation will be holes 18, 10, 16, 17 & 18 repeated, unless otherwise determined by the Committee.
