



NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for NebGolf Championships)

1. **Abnormal Course Conditions** include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Decorative flower and plant beds.
2. **Advice:** Model Local Rule H-2 is in effect. Each team may name two advice givers whom players on the team may ask for advice and receive advice from during the round, so long as:
 - a. Each advice giver is designated by the institution's athletic department to perform coaching duties; and
 - b. They must be identified to NebGolf before any player on the team begins their round.
3. **Caddies:** Model Local Rule H-1.1 is in effect. Rule 10.3a is modified in this way:
 - a. A player must not have a caddie during the round.
4. **Immovable Obstructions**, include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Artificially surfaced roads and paths including those surfaced with crushed rock, gravel and asphalt.
 - b. Immovable obstructions adjacent to, within or abutting each other, such as artificially surfaced paths (including decorative areas enclosed by these paths), curbing, walls, steps and drains, are considered a single obstruction.
 - c. Permanent restrooms and structures, including adjacent and surrounding artificially surfaced paths, patios, and decorative plantings, are considered a single obstruction.
 - d. Staked (including wire and mulched tree wells associated with staked trees) are deemed to be immovable obstructions.
5. **Movable Obstructions**, include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Staking and roping; trash cans; benches; and beverage coolers.
6. **Penalty Areas:**
 - a. The yellow penalty area on hole #6 plays as a red penalty area during the play of any other hole.
 - b. Dropping Zones - If a ball is in the following penalty areas, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:
 - i) proceed under Rule 17.1; or
 - ii) as an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone (marked "DZ") in the location below. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3
 - Hole #5 Yellow Penalty Area - DZ located left of the penalty area.
 - Hole #6 Yellow Penalty Area - DZ located on the forward tee.
 - Hole #7 Yellow Penalty Area - DZ located in the fairway.
7. **Out of Bounds:**
 - a. Defined by white stakes and white lines in addition to perimeter fence posts and telephone poles painted with a white stripe.
8. **Scoring Area:** A score card is returned when it has been given to the scoring official and the player has left the immediate scoring area.
9. **Teeing Area:**
 - a. Men - Red NebGolf tee markers.
 - b. Women - White NebGolf tee markers.
10. **Play-Off:** In the event of a tie for the team champion in each division, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off, scoring all five scores on each hole until a winner is determined. In the event of a tie for the individual champion in each division, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off until a winner is determined. The play-off rotation will be holes #10, #11, #17 and #18 repeated, unless otherwise determined by the Committee.
11. **Transportation:** Model Local Rule G-6 is in effect. During the round, a player must not ride on any form of motorized transportation except as authorized or later approved by the Committee. A player who will play, or has played, under penalty of stroke and distance is always authorized to ride on motorized transportation.
12. **Final Decisions on Disputed Points** will be made by Justin Ahrens, Craig Ames, Juliana Botero and Ben Vigil.
